PROCLAMATION, For pardoning Deferters from the Militia Forces.

GEORGE R.

THEREAS by an Act, paffed in the laft Sef-WHEREAS by an AA, paffed in the laft Sef-fion of Parliament, intituled, An AA for the Reduction of the Militia Forces, at the Time and in the Manner therein limited; for enabling His Majefty more effectually to encreafe His Re-gular Forces for the vigorous Profecution of the War; and for amending the Laws relating to the Militia; it is, amongft other Things, enaCted, That it fhall and may be lawful for Us, by Our Royal Proclamation, pardoning, if We fhall think fit, all or any fuch Militia Men as fhall have enlifted into any of Our Regular Forces before the paffing of fuch Act, to direct that fuch Men fo pardoned fhall fuch Act, to direct that fuch Men fo pardoned shall not be liable to be claimed by, or returned to ferve in the Regiment, Battalion, or Company of Militia from which they shall have deferted; and further, to pardon every fuch Militia Man as had, before the paffing of the faid Act, deferted from any fuch Regiment, Battalion, or Company of Militia, on Condition that fuch Militia Man fhall voluntarily furrender himfelf, as a Deferter, on or before the First Day of August, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, or fhall, on or before the faid First Day of August, voluntarily enlift into fome one of Our Regular Regiments; and to direct that such Militia Man fo pardoned, and enlifting, shall not be liable to be claimed by, or returned to ferve in the Regiment, Battalion, or Company aforefaid: And all Militia Men who shall have deferted at any Time before the passing of fuch Act, and who shall not have furrendered themfelves, or enlifted as aforefaid, in confequence of fuch Proclamation, on or before the Firlt Day of August, One thouland feven hundred and ninety-nine, shall be liable to be tried, and punished, as in the said Act mentioned: And whereas We are graciously disposed to extend Our Mercy to Offenders who may be willing to take the Benefit of the faid Act, We have, therefore, thought fit, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to iffue this Our Royal Proclamation; and We do hereby, for Us, Our Heirs and Succeffors, pardon

and remit all and every Offence and Offences of Defertion, from any Regiment, Battalion, or Company of Militia, committed by any Perfon before the Twelfth Day of July inftant, the Day of paffing fuch Act; provided fuch Perfon shall, before the paffing of the faid Act, have enlifted into any of Our Regular Forces, or shall voluntarily furrender himfelf as a Deferter, on or before the faid Firft Day of August, One thousand feven hundred and ninety-nine, and shall, on or before the faid First Day of August, One thousand feven hundred and ninety-nine, voluntarily enlift into fome one of Our Regular Regiments; and We do hereby direct that every fuch Man fo pardoned, and enlifting, or hav-ing enlifted as aforefaid, shall not be liable to be claimed by, or returned to ferve in the Regiment, Battalion, or Company of Militia from which he deferted : And We do alfo releafe and difcharge fuch Offenders respectively from all Profecutions, Im-prisonments, and Penalties, commenced or incurred for or by Reason of any such Offence, so pardoned as aforelaid.

Given at Our Court at St. James's, the Twentyfourth Day of July, One thousand feven hun-dred and ninety-nine, in the Thirty-ninth Year of Our Reign.
