" brought from Foreign Parts into Great Britain " or Ireland, or the Isles of Guernsey, Jersey, * Alderney, Sark, or Man," it is among many other Things enacted, that all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes whatfoever, coming or imported into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or any of the Isles before-mentioned, from any Place from whence His Maiefty, his Heirs or Succeffors, by and with the Advice of his or their Privy Council, shall judge it probable that the Infection may be brought, shall be obliged to make their Quarantine in fuch Place and Places, for fuch Time, and in fuch Manner as has been, or shall from Time to Time be directed by His Majefty, his Heirs or Succeffors, by his or their Order or Orders made in his or their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette: And that until fuch Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes shall have refpectively performed and be difcharged from fuch Quarantine, no fuch Perfons, Goods, or Merchandizes, or any of them, shall come or be brought on Shore, or go or be put on board any other Ship or Vessel, in any Place within His Majesty's Dominions, unlefs in fuch Manner, and in fuch Cafes, and by fuch Licence as shall be directed or permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majefty, his Heirs or Succeffors, in Council as aforefaid : And that all fuch Ships and Veffels, and the Perfons or Goods coming or imported in, or going or being put on board the fame; and all Ships Veffels, Boats, and Perfons receiving any Goods or Perfons out of the fame, shall be fubject to fuch Orders, Rules, and Directions concerning Quarantine, and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or shall be made by His Majesty, his Heirs and Succeffors, in Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette as afore-mentioned, under fuch Pains and Penalties as are inflicted by the faid Act: And whereas by an Act, paffed in the Thirty-eighth Year of His prefent Majefty, intituled An Act to amend Two Acts, made in the Twenty-fixth Year of King George George the Second, and the Twenty-eighth Year of His prefent Majefty, respecting the Performance of Quarantine, &c. it is enacted, that the faid Acts paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, and the Twenty eighth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, and all and every other Acts or Act of Parliament then in Force in any Way regarding the Performance of Quarantine, shall be extended to all fuch Difeases or Distempers as His Majefty, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, shall judge to be probably infectious, and shall fo declare by Order in Council, notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette: And whereas Information has been received of a

" for the better preventing the Plague being | malignant Difease existing in the City of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennfylvania, and in New York, within the United States of America, and that the fame is probably infectious; His Majefty, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, doth deem it expedient to declare, and by this Order doth declare, that the faid malignant Difeafe is probably infectious, within the Intent and Meaning of the faid Act of the Thirty-eighth Year of His Majefty's Reign, and doth order, and it is hereby ordered, that all Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizcs now arrived, or that shall hereafter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom, or the Ifles of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, or Man, from Philadelphia and New York, or any Port within the State of Pennfylvania, or any Port within the Province of New York, do make their Quarantine for Fourteen Days, which is to commence and be computed from the Day each Ship or Veffel shall come to Anchor in the Place appointed for the Performance of Quarantine, and not before.

> That the Places hereinafter named shall be and are hereby appointed to be the Places wherein fuch Ships or Veffels (not having the Infection on board) shall respectively perform Quarantine, that is to fay; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Port of London, or any Member, Creek, or other Parts thereof, or to the River Thames or Medway, shall perform their Quarantine in Standgate Creek ; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Ipswich, Yarmouth, Lynn, Bofton, Hull, Newcaltle, or Berwick upon Tweed, or any of them, or any Member or Creek thereof, or other Place therein, shall perform their Quarantine in Whitebooth Road, between Hull and Grimfby; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Carlifle and Chefter, or either of them, or any Member or Creek thereof, or other Place therein, or to any Part of the Isle of Man, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place called Highlake, near Liverpool, at the Weft End thercof; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Milford, Cardiff, Gloucester, Briftol, Bridgewater, or any of them, or any Member or Creek of them, or any of them, or to Padítow or St. Ive's, being Members of the Port of Plymouth, or to Ilfracombe or Barnftaple, being Members of the Port of Exeter, or to any other Place within the faid Ports of Milford, Cardiff, Gloucester, Briftol, or Bridgewater, or within the faid Members or Creeks, shall perform their Quarantine in Kingroad and Porfhute Pill; all Ships or Vefiels which are or fhall be bound to the Ports of Plymouth, except fuch Parts thereof as have been hereinbefore-mentioned, or to the Port of Exeter, except fuch Parts thereof as have been hereinbefore-mentioned, or to the Port of Pool, or
