THE Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury have given Directions for paying off the Exchequer bills issued pursuant to Act 38 Geo. III. Cap. 90. for enabling His Majesty to raise the Sum of One Million for the Uses and Purposes therein mentioned. And such of the Exchequer Bills issued pursuant to Act 39 Geo. III. Cap. 41, for raising a further Sum of Money by Loans or Exchequer Bills for the Service of the Year 1799, as were charged on the Fifth and Sixth Instalments of a Loan granted by an Act of the same Session of Parliament for raising the Sum of 15,500,000l. by way of Annuities, and which were not paid in on the said Instalments respectively; and that the Principal and Interest of all the said Exchequer-Bills shall be paid at the Exchequer-Bill Office in Saint Margaret's Street, between the Two Palace-Yards, Westminster, on Friday the 31st of this instant January, on which Day the Interest on the said Exchequer-Bills will cease; and Attendance will be given on Monday next the 20th Instant, and every succeeding Day, (Sunday only excepted,) until Monday the 27th of this instant January inclusive, from Ten o'Clock in the Morning till One in the Afternoon, for the Purpose of receiving the same; and for the greater Dispatch, the Bearers of the said Bills are desired to bring separate Lists of each Description of Bills, containing the Numbers in numerical Order, according to the Value of the said Bills, Times of Commencement of Interest, with the Principal Sums and Interest due on such Bills, to be computed at Threepence Halfpenny by the Day on every 100l. from the Time of Commencement to the said 31st Day of January 1800, on which Day the Interest on the said Exchequer-Bills will cease; and they are desired to write their Names on the said Bills.
