By the KING. A PROCLAMATION,

For granting the Distribution of Prizes taken from the Persons inhabiting the Coasts and Ports of Genoa, and the Territories of the Pope, subsequent to the Twenty-eighth Day of September One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, the Date of His Majesty's Order in Council for granting General Reprifals against the Ships and Goods of the said Persons, then subject to the pretended Authority of Governments flyling themselves the Ligurian and Roman Republics.

7HEREAS, by Our Order in Council dated the Twenty-eighth Day of September One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, We have ordered that General Reprifals should be granted against the Ships and Goods belonging to the Perfons inhabiting the Coasts and Ports of Genoa and the Territories of the Pope, then subject to the pretended Authority of Governments styling themfelves the Ligurian and the Roman Republics, fo that, as well Our Fleet and Ships, as also all other Ships and Vessels that shall be commissionated by Letters of Marque or General Reprifals, or otherwise, by Our Commissioners for executing Our Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully feize all Ships and Goods belonging to the faid Persons, and bring the same to Judgment in any of Our Courts of Admiralty within Our Dominions: We, being desirous to give due Encouragement to all Our faithful Subjects who may have lawfully feized any fuch Ships or Goods fubfequent to the faid Twenty-eighth Day of September One thousand seven hundred and ninetyeight, or who shall hereafter seize such Ships or Goods (fave and except as to fuch Ships and Goods belonging to Persons inhabiting the Territories of the Pope, which may have been feized subsequent

thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, or which shall hereafter be seized,) and having declared in Council Our Intentions concerning the Distribution of all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes, and Reprifals of all fuch Ships and Goods already feized, or which shall be seized as aforesaid, do now make known to all Our loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern, by this Our Proclamation, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, that Our Will and Pleasure is, that the neat Produce of all fuch Ships and Goods already taken or which shall be taken as aforesaid, the Right whereofis inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given to the Takers (fave and except as aforefaid); and also, fave and except the Produce of such Prizes as are or shall be taken by Ships or Vessels belonging to Our Commissioners of Cultoms or Excise, the Disposition of which We referve to Our further Pleafure, but subject to the Payment of all such or the like Customs and Duties as the same are now, or would have been liable to, if the fame were or might have been imported as Merchandize; and that the same may be so given in the Proportion and Manner hereinafter fet forth; that is to fay, That all Prizes taken by Ships and Vessels having Commissions of Letters of Marque and Reprisals. (fave and except fuch Prizes as are or shall be taken by the Ships or Vessels belonging to Our Commissioners aforesaid,) may be fold and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others, to whom such Letters of Marque and Reprisals are granted, for their own Use and Benefit, after final Adjudication, and not before; and We do hereby further order and direct, That the neat Produce of all Prizes which are or shall be taken as aforesaid by any of Our Ships or Vessels of War, shall be for the entire Benefit and Encouragement of Our Flag Officers, Captains, Commanders, and other Commisfioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Seamen, to the Twenty-seventh Day of September One Marines, and Soldiers, on board Our faid Ships
