La Terrailleuse, (Schooner) Fourteen Guns, Six-Pounders, and Eighty Men.

I have to lament that, from the Puffllanimity of the Enemy, I had it not in my Power to destroy the Whole, or of trying the Zeal of my Officers and young Ship's Company, but have everything to fay in their Favor for the Activity and Chearfulness they shewed on the Occasion, and hope some future Day we shall be more fortunate. On the following Day we recaptured the American Ship Perfeverance, of Baltimore, with a Cargo valued at Thirty Thousand Pounds.

The Vengeance is Two Years old, and has been repeatedly chased by our Frigates, but from her superior Sailing escaped; nor should we have caught her, had not she carried away her Jib-Boom.
