I Have the Honor to acquaint your Lordfhip, that His Majefty's Ship under my Command captured on the 1ft Inftant, Twelve Leagues to the Southward of the Hieres the French Pair T Southward of the Hieres, the French Brig La Cruelle of Six Guns (Four of which were thrown overboard in the Chace), and Forty-three Men, commanded by Francis Xavier Jeard, Enfeigne de Vaisseau, with a Cargo of all Sorts of Provisions; she had been only Eight Hours from Toulon, failed with Sealed Orders, but from what I can learn I have little Doubt but fhe was deftined for Malta; La Cruelle has been a Bomb Veffel, but left her Mortar at Toulon.
