A T the Court at St. James's, the 29th of July 1800,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. WHEREAS by an Act paffed in the prefent VV Seffion of Parliament, intituled, "An AA " for erecting a Lazaret on Chetney Hill, in the " County of Kent, and for reducing into one Act " the Laws relating to Quarantine, and for making "further Provisions therein," it is, among other Things enacted, that from and after the first Day of October One thousand eight hundred, all Ships and Vessels arriving, and all Persons, Goods, and Merchandizes whatfoever coming or imported into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or the Illes of Guernfey, Jerley, Alderney, Sark, or Man, from any Place from whence His Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, by and with the Advice and Confent of his or their Privy Council, fhall judge it probable that the Plague or other Infectious Difeafe or Diffemper which His Majefty, with the Advice of his Privy Council, fhall, from Time to Time, declare to be of the Nature of the Plague may be brought, shall be liable and obliged to make their Quarantine in fuch Place and Places, for fuch Time, and in fuch Manner, as shall, from Time to Time be directed by His Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, by his or 'their Order or Orders of Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette; and that until fuch Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes shall have respectively performed, and shall be duly discharged from fuch Quarantine, no fuch Perfon, Goods, or Merchandizes, or any of them, shall come or be brought on Shore, or go, or be put on board any other Ship or Veffel in any Place within His Majefly's Dominions, unlefs in fuch Manner, and in fuch Cafes, and by fuch Licence as shall be directed or permitted by fuch Dicerce as man be directed by permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors in Coun-cil as aforefaid; and that all fuch Ships and Vefiels, and the Perfors or Goods coming or imported in, or going, or being put on board the fame, and all Ships, Veffels, Boats, and Perfons receiving any Goods or Perfons out of the fame, fhall be fubject to fuch Orders, Rules, and Direc. tions concerning Quarantine, and the prevention of Infection as fhall be made by His Majefty, his Heirs, and Succeffors, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, and notified by his Royal Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette, under fuch Pains and Penalties as are inflicted by the faid Act.

And whereas His Majefty has judged it expedient to make Regulations with Refpect to the Performance of Quarantine, in Addition to those established in the faid above-recited Act, and doth judge it probable that the Infection of the Plague may be brought into this Kingdom by Ships or Vessel coming from or through the Mediterranean, or from the West Barbary on the Atlantic Ocean, with or without clean Bills of Health; and also by the Importation into this Kingdom of certain Goods, Wares, and Merchandizes, the Growth, Produce, or Manufacture of Turkey, or of any Place in Africa within the Streights of Gibraltar, or in the West Barbary on the Atlantic Ocean, from any Port or Place in Holland, or from any Port or Place whatever where there is not a regular Establishment for the Performance of Quarantine, His Majesty is hereby pleased, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered,

I. That all Ships and Veifels (not having the Plague * or other infectious Difeafe or Diffemper, which fhall, by His Majefty, with the Advice of his Privy Council, have been declared to be of the Nature of the Plague, actually on board), coming from or through the Mediterranean, or from the Welt Barbary on the Atlantic Ocean, with clean Bills of Health ; and all Ships and Veffels whatfoever having on board Cotton-Wool, (except Ships and Veffels coming directly from the Eaft Indies, or from the Continent of America, or the Weft Indies, loaded in Whole or in Part with that Commodity, being the Produce of thofe Parts,) or any of the Goods, Wares, or Merchandizes enumerated in the Firft Clafs hereinafter flated, being the

* By former Acts of Parliament, as well as by the Act of laft Seffion, Ships and Veffels having the Plague on heard, or other infectious Differed or Diffemper of the Nature of the Plague, are not to approach the Ports of this Kingdom, but are immediately to proceed to Saint Helen's Pool in the Ifland of Seilly.
