As feveral Artificers and Manufacturers, Subjects of Great Britain, have, from Time to Time, gone into Foreign Countries to exercife their feveral Callings, contrary to the Laws of thefe Kingdoms, the follow-ing Abfracts of Acts of Parliament of Their laie Majeflies King George the First and Second, and of His prefent Majefly, for preventing fuch Practices, are published, for the Information of all Perfons who may be ignorant of the Penalties they may incur-by Difobedience to them : And it will be observed, that fuch Penalties likewife extend to those who are any ways concerned or instrumental in the Sending or Enticing Artificers or Manufacturers out of these Kingdoms, or in the Exportation of the Tools and Instruments used by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufacturers themfelves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27.

IF any Person shall contract with, entice, or folicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brass, or other Metal, Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer of Great Britain, to go into Foreign Countries out of the King's Dominions, and shall be convicted thereof, upon Indictment or Information in any of the Courts at Westminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter Seffions, he shall be fined any Sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for the first Offence, and shall be imprisoned Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Perfon having been once convicted shall offend again, he shall be fined at the Diferetion of the Court, and imprifoned Twelve Months, and till the Fine be paid.

If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Artificers, shall go into any Country out of His Majesty's Dominions, to exercise or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any luch Foreign Country, exercifing any of the faid Trades, shall not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minifter, or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artificers shall be, or by any Perfon authorifed by fuch Ambaflador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from henceforth inhabit within this Realm ; fuch Perfons shall be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor or Administrator, or of taking any Lands, &c.: within this Kingdom, by Defcent, Devife, or Purchafe, and shall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majefly's or any Part of fuch Tools, he shall, for every Of-

Use, and shall be deemed Alien, and out of His Majesty's Protection.

Upon Complaint made, upon Oath, before any Juffice of Peace, that any Perfon is endeavour-ing to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted or is preparing to go out of His Majefty's Dominions, for the Purpoles aforefaid, fuch Juffice may fend his Warrant to bring the Perfon complained of before him, or before fome other Juffice; and if it shall appear by the Oath of One Witnels, or by Confession, that he was guilty of any of the faid Offences, fuch Jultice may bind him to appear at the next Affizes or Quarter Sef-fions: Aud if fuch Perfon shall refuse to give Security, the Juffice may commit him to Gaol till the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions, and until he shall be delivered by due Course of Law. And if any fuch Artificer shall be convicted, upon Indictment, of any fuch Promife, Contract, or Preparation to go beyond the Scas, for the Purpole aforefaid, he shall give fuch Security to the King not to depart out of His Majetty's Dominions, as fuch Court shall think reafonable, and shall be imprisoned till Security given.

If any of the above Offences shall be committed in Scotland, the fame shall be profecuted in the Court of Jufficiary or the Circuits there.

Statute 23 George II. Chap. 13.

IF any Perfon shall contract with, or endeavour to feduce any Artificer in Wool, Mohair, Cot-ton, or Silk, or in Iron, Steel, Brass, or other Metal, or any Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer in any other of the Manufactures of Great Britain or Ireland, to go out of this Kingdom or Ireland into any Foreign Country not within the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, and shall be convicted, upon Indictment or Information, in the Kings Bench at Weltminster, or by Indictment at the Assizes or General Gaol Delivery for the County, &c. wherein such Offence shall be committed in England, or by Indictment in the Court of Jufficiary or any of the Circuit Courts in Scotland, or by Indictment or Information in the King's Bench at Dublin, if fuch Offence be committed in Ireland; the Perfon fo convicted thall, for every Ar-tificer contracted with or feduced, forceit FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS, and thall fuffer Impri-fonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Forfeiture he paid: And in cafe of a fubfequent Offence of the fame Kind, the Perfous fo again offending (hall forfeit, for every Perfon contracted with or feduced, ONE THOUSANI) POUNDS, and shall fuffer, Impriforment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fach Offender shall be convicted, for Two Years, and until fuch Forfeiture be paid."

If any Perfon in Great Britain or Ireland shall put on beard any Ship or Boat, not bound directly to fome Port in Gaeat Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, any fuch Fools or Utenfils as are commonly
