Fowers of Two Acts made in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of His late Majefly King George the Second, and the Nineteenth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefly, for repairing and widening the Roads from the East End of Brough-under Stainmore, in the County of Weftmorland, by the End of Appleby Bridge to Eamont Bridge, in the faid County.

An ACt for repairing and widening the Road from the Town of Rugby, in the County of Warwick, to join the Turnpike Road leading from Lutterworth to Market Harborough, in the Counties of Leicefter and Northampton.

An Act to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and alter the Powers of Two Acts, one paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, initialed, An Act to widen and repair the Road from the Guide Poft, near the End of Drayton-Lane, near Banbury, in the County of Oxford, to the Houfe called the Sun Rifing, at the Top of Edge-Hill, in the County of Warwick; and the other paffed in the Twentieth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty King George the Third, for enlarging the Term and Powers of the faid Act.

An Act for continuing for Twenty one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Selfion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of Two Acts paffed in the Thirty-firth Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, and in the Twentieth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, for repairing and widening feveral Roads therein mentioned, fo far as the fame Acts relate to the Road from the Market-Houfe in Tetbury to the Turnpike Road on Minchinhampton Common, and from the faid Road, in Minchinhampton Field, unto the Turnpike Road from Circnecetter to Stroud, near Burnt Afh, and from the faid Turnpike Road to Tayloe's Mill Pond, in Chalford-Bottom, and through Hide to the Bottom of the Bowm-Hill, in the County of Gloucefter, and for repairing, altering, and improving the Road from Tayloe's Mill-Pond aforelaid, to Fofton's-Afh, in the Parifh of Bifley, in the faid County of Gloucefter.

An Act for more effectually repairing, widening, diverting, and improving the Road leading from Reading, in the County of Berks, to Bafingftoke, in the County of Southampton.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-One Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of an Act paffed in the Twentieth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty for making and maintaining the Road from Sage Crofs, in the Town of Melton Mowbray, in the County of Leicefter, to the Town of Grantham, in the County of Lincola.

An AA to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and alter and enlarge the Powers of an AA paffed in the Thirty-full Year of the Reign of His late Majetty Kmg George the Second, for widening and repairing feveral Roads leading from the Welch-Gate and Gotton-Hill, in the Town of Shrewfoury, in the County of Salop, and for making and maintaining a new Branch of

Road, from the prefent Road, from Shrewfbury to Welfh Pool, at or near the Tenth Mile-Stone to or near to Buttington-Hall, in the County of Montgomery.

An Act to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and alter and enlarge the Powers of Two Acts, paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of His late Majefly King George the Second, and in the Nineteenth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefly, for repairing and widening the Road leading from Flimwell Vert, in the Parifla of Ticehurfly, in the County of Suffex, to the Town and Port of Haftings, in the faid County.

An Act to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and alter and enlarge the Powers of Two Acts, paffed in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, and in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, for repairing and widening the Road from the Bars at Boughton, within the Liberties of the City of Chefter to Whitchurch, and from thence to Newport, in the County of Salop, and feveral other Roads therein mentioned, fo far as the faid Acts relate to the Road leading from Whitchurch aforefaid, through Ternhill to Newport aforefaid, being the Second Diftrict of Roads in the faid Acts mentioned.

An Act for continuing the Term and Powers of Two Acts, palied in the Thirty-fecond Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, and the Twentieth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, for repairing and widening the Road from the Town of Mansfield, in the County of Nottingham, through the Towns of Pleafley, Glapwell, Heath, and Normenton, and the Liberty of Hafland, to the Turopike Road leading from the Town of Derby to the Town of Chefterfield, in the County of Derby.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years and from thence to the End of the then next Sefficer of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers, of Two Acts paffed in the First and Tenth Years of the Reign of His prefent Majefly KingGeorge the Third, for repairing and widening, the Road from the East End of West Taphous Lane to the Borough of Liskeard, and from thence to the Coombe Row House, and several other Roads therein mentioned, in the Counties of Cornwall and Devon.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers, of Two Acts paffed in the Thirtyfecond Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, and in the Twentieth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, for repairing and widening feveral Roads therein mentioned, fo far as, the faid Acts relate to the Road leading from the Town of Wrexham to the Towns of Ruthin and Deubigh, in the County of Denbigh; and amending, widening, altering, improving, and keeping in Repair, the Road leading from the faid Town of Ruthin into the Turnpike Road from Corwen to Llanrwft, at or near a certain Houfe called Cernioge. Mawr, in the Parifh of Llanufydd, in the faid County.
