

People will continue to be manifested by such Efforts and Sacrifices, as may be necessary for asserting the Honour of His Majesty's Crown, and for maintaining the permanent Interests of the Empire.

Then a Commission for proroguing the Parliament was read.

After which the Lord Chancellor said;

My Lords and Gentlemen,

**B**y Virtue of His Majesty's Commission under the Great Seal, to us and other Lords directed, and now read, we do, in His Majesty's Name, and in Obedience to His Commands, prorogue this Parliament to Thursday the Sixth Day of August next, to be then here holden; and this Parliament is accordingly prorogued to Thursday the Sixth Day of August next.
