## A PROCLAMATION,

For pardening fuch Seamen and Morines as bave deJetted, and ßall return into His Majeßy's Service on or before the Firf Day of Scptember next.

GEORGE R .

WHEREAS We are defirous to give all due Encouragement to fuch Seamen as may have deferted from any of Our Ships, and fhall bc willing to return to Our Service: We have thought fit, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to publinh this :Our Royal Proclamation, and do hereby promile Our moft gracious Pardon to all fuch Deferters as fhall repair on board any of Our Ships or Veffels on or before the Pirft Day of September next; and We do hereby further promife Our mof gracious Pardon to all fuch Seamen as having deferted are now belonging to fome One of Our Ships (in which Ship they are hereby permitted to continue), and do declare that fuch Deferters thail be entitles to receive all Wages that may be due to them in the Ship from which they may have deferted, at the Time of fuch Defertion; and We do alfo hereby promife Our mott gacious Pardon to all Marines who may have deferted from Our Service, and fhall, on or before the faid Firft Day of September next, furrender themfelves at the Head-Quarters of the Marines eftablifled at Purtimouth, Plymouth, or Ciatham, or to any Recruiting Party of Our faid Forces; and We do hereby dechare that all Seamen and Marines fo Currendering themfelves as aforefaid thall be rekeafed and difcharged from all Profecutions, lmprifonments, and Penaities commenced or incurred by Reafon of any fach Offence; but We do hereby further declare that all fuch Deferters; whether Seamen or Marines, who thall not, on or before the faid Firft Day of September next, furrender themfelves on board One of Our Ships or Velfels of War, or at the Head Quarters of the Marines
eftablifhed at Portfmouth, Plymouth, or Chatham or to fome Recruiting Party of the faid Forces, or who thall hereafter abfent themfehws from the Ships to which they belong, or from the Marine Quarters, without Leave frem their Commanding Offcers, fhall be tried at a Court Martial, and being found guilty thall be deemed unfit:Objects of Our Royal Mercy, and fhall fuffer the Punifhment of Death, or fuch other Punihment as they thall be condemned to fuffer by Sentence of the faid Court.

Given at Our Court at IVeymonth, the Thirtieth Day of Fuly One thoufand eight hundred and one, and in the Forty-firlt Year of Our Reign. GOD fave the KING.

WHEREAS the Time limited by His Ma jelty's Order in Council, of the Eleventh of February laf, prohibiting the exporting into any Parts out of this IVingdum, of any Sheet Coppers or Copper in Boliftaves, Bars, Sheets, Ringe, and Nails, or of Copper in fuch a State as may be cafly converted into, or made ufeful as a Naval Store, will expire upon the Twelfth Day of Auguft next; and whereas it is expedient for His Majelty's Service, and the Safety of this Kingdom, that the faid Prohibition hould be, in Part, continued for fome Time longer, His Majefty doth, therefore, with the Advice of His Yrivy Council, hereby order, require, and command, that no Perion or Perfons whofoever, do at any Time for the Space of Six Months, to commence from the faid Twelfth Day of Auguft next, prefume to export out of this Kingdom to any Parts beyond the Seas, within the Limits of Europe, any Sheet Copper, or Copper in Bolthaves, Bars, Sheets, Rings, and Nails, or anj Copper capa-
