The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS the Time limited by His Majefty's W Order in Council of the Third Day of February laft, prohibiting the Exportation out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coaltwife, Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire upon the Seventh Day of April. next: And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majefty's Service that the faid Prohibition should be continued for fome Time longer; His Majefty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfox or Perfons whatloever (except the Mafter General of the Ordnance for His Majefty's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Two Months, to commence from the Seventh Day of April next, prefume to tranf-port into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coaffwife, any Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or thip or lade any Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, on board any Ship or Veffel, in order to transporting the fame into any Parts be-yond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coaltwife, without Leave or Permission in that Behalf first obtained from His Majefty, or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuffering the refpective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by an Act, paffed in the Twenty-ninth Year of His late Majefty's Reign, intituled "An Act to empower His Ma-"jelty to prohibit the Exportation of Saltpetre, " and to enforce the Law for empowering His Ma-" jelly to prohibit the Exportation of Gunpowder, " or any Sort of Arms and Ammunition ; and alfo " to empower His Majelty to reftrain the carrying " Coaffwife of Saltpetre, Gunpowder, or any Sort " of Arms or Ammunition."-And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majefly's Treafury, the Commiffiquers for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Mafter-General

WHEREAS the Time limited by His Majelly's Order in Council of the Third Day of February laft, prohibiting the Transportation into any Parts out of this Kingdom, of the Wood called Lignum Vitz, will expire upon the Tenth Day of April next: And whereas it is judged expe-dient for His Majefty's Service that the faid Prohibition should be continued for fome Time longer; His Majefty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and. command, that no Perfon or Perfons whofoever do... at any Time during the Space of Two Months, to commence from the Tenth Day of April next, export, or attempt to export, transport, carry, or convey, or lade, or lay on board of any Ship, Veffel, or Boat, in order to be exported, tranfported, carried, or conveyed out of this Kingdom. ported, carried, or conveyed out of this Kingdom-any of the Wood called Lignum Vitæ, without Leave or Permiflion being first had and obtained of His Majefty or His Privy Council : But it is; neverthelefs, His Majefty's Pleafure, that nothing herein contained fhall extend, or be construct to extend, to prevent any Ship or Vefiel from taking or having on board any of the faid Wood called Lignum Vitæ, which may be needfary for the Ule of the faid Ship or Vefiel during the Courfe of her intended Voyage : nor to prevent the Fr of her intended Voyage; nor to prevent the Ex-portation of the faid Wood called Lignum Vitæ to Ireland, or to His Majelty's Islands of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, or Man, or to His Majelty's Colonies or Plaintations in America or the West Indies, or to Newfoundland, or to His Majelly's Forts and Settlements on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or to the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies Provided that, upon the Exportation of the fait Wood called Lignum Vite to Ireland, or to His of the Ordnance, and His Majefty's Secretary at | Majefty's Islands of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney,
