THE King has been pleafed to grant the Dig-nity of a Baronels of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland to the Moft Honorable Mary Marchionefs of Downshire, Widow of the Most Honorable Arthur late Marquis of Downthe non Honorabic Article Interquis of Down-fhire, for and during her natural Life, by the Name, Style, and Title of Lady Sandys, Baronels of Omberfley, in the County of Worcefler, and from and immediately after her Deceale, the Dig-nity of a Baron of the faid United Kingdom to the Bight Honorable Arthur Marin William the Right Honorable Arthur Moyfes William Hill, (commonly called Lord Arthur Moyfes William Hill,) Second Son of the faid Arthur late Marquis of Downfhire by the faid Mary his Wife, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully begotten, and in default of fuch Iffue to the Right Honorable Arthur Margue Capil Hill (commonly Honorable Arthur Marcus Cecil Hill, (commonly called Lord Arthur Marcus Cecil Hill,) Third Son of the faid Arthur, late Marquis of Downshire, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully begotten; and in default of fuch Islue to the Right Honorable Arthur Augustus Edwin Hill, (commonly called Lord Arthur Augustus Edwin Hill,) Fourth Son of the faid Arthur, late Marquis of Downshire, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully begotten; and, in default of fuch Iffue to the Right Honorable George Augusta Hill, (commonly called Lord George Augusta Hill,) Fifth Son of the faid Ar-thur, late Marquis of Downshire, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully bego ten; and in default of fuch Iffue to the Most Honorable Arthur Blundell Sandys Trumbull Marquis of Downshire, Eldest Son of the faid Arthur, late Marquis of Downshire, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully begotten.

The King has been pleafed to grant unto Eliza-beth Cocks and Sally Cocks, of Middleton-Hall, in the Parish of Middleton, St. George, in the County-Palatine of Durham, Spinfters, His Royal Licence and Authority, that they may take and ule the Sur-name and bear the Arms of Pemberton only, in compliance with the particular Requeft of their late Nephew William Pemberton, of Middleton-Hall aforefaid, Efg; decealed, as well as to tellify their affectionate Regard for his Memory ; fuch Arms

being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Herald's Office :

And also to order, that this His Majesty's Conceffion and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
