PRESENT, The KING's Molt Excellent Majeity in Council. W7 HEREAS by an Act, paffed in the Twenty-cighth Year of the Reign of His prefent Maichy, initialed " An Act for regulating the Trade between the Subjects of His Majelly's Colonies and Plantations in North America, and in the Well India Islands, and the Countries belonging to the United States of America, and between His Maje'by's faid Subjects and the Foreign Iflands in the Weat Indies;" it is, amongft other Things, enached, That it faall and may be lawful for His Majedy in Council, by Order or Orders to be iffued and publified from Time to Time, to anthorife, or by Warrant or Warrants under His Sign Manual, the counter the Covernor of Newfound'and for to empower the Governor of Newfound'and, for the Time being, to authorize, in Cafe of Necessity, the Importation into Newfoundland of Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, from any of the Territories belonging to the faid United States for the Supply of the Inhabitants and Fifhermen of the Iflund of Newfoundland for the then enfuing Seafon only; provided always, That fuch Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, fo authorized to be andian Corn, and Live Stock, to authorized to be imported into the Ifland of Newfoundland, fhall not be imported encept in Conformity to fuch Pules, Regulations, and Refiricitions as shall be fpecified in fuch Order or Orders, Warrant or Warrants respectively, and except by British Sub-jects, and in Erbish built Ships, owned by His Majelly's Subjects, and navigated according to Later And whereas it is exceedent and practition Law: And whereas it is expedient and neochary that Provision be made for fully supplying the In-habitants or Filhermen of the Found of Newfoundland, for the enfoing Seafoa, with Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, Will Dicas, Fibil, Indian Corn, and Live Stock. Fils Majefty doth Council, hereby order and declare, That, for the Supply of the Inhabitants and Fifthermen of the Supply of the inhabitants and Philormen of the Island of New foundland for the caling Seaton only, Brend, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock may be imported into the faid Island from any of the Perritories belonging to the faid United States by British Subjects, and in British-built Ships, owned by His Majerty's Subjects, and navigated according

T the Court at St. James's, the 22d of to Law; and which, within the Space of Nine December 1802, Months previous to the Time of fuch Importation, have cleared out from fome Port of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, or other His Majefty's Dominions in Europe, for which Purpole a Licence shall have been granted by the Corumifioners of His Majefty's Cuftoms in England or Scotland, or the Commissioners of His Majelty's Revenue in Ireland, or any other Perfon or Perfons who may be duly authorized in that Kingdom re-spectively, in the Manner and Form hereinafter mentioned; which Licence shall continue and he in Force for Nine Calendar Months from the Day of the Date upon which fuch Licence is respectively granted, and no longer; provided that no fuch Li-cence as aforefaid, granted after the Thirtieth Day of September next, thall be of any Force or Effect. And His Majefty is hereby further pleafed to order, That the Malter or Perfon having the Charge or Command of any Ship or Veffel to whom fuch Li-cence fhall be granted, fhall, upon the Arrival of the faid Ship or Veffel at the Pert, Harbour or Place in the Ifland of Newfoundland, where he thall difcharge fuch Bread, Flour, Indian Cora, and Live Stock, deliver up the faid Licence to the Collector or other proper Officer of the Cuffoms there, having first indorfed on the Back of fuch Licence the Marks, Numbers, and Contents of each Package of Bread, Flour, or Indian Corn, and the Number of Live Stock, under the Penalty. of the Forfeiture in the faid Act mentioned ; and the Collector or other proper Officer of the Cuftoms at Newfoundland is hereby enjoined and required to give a Certificate to the Mafter or Perfon having the Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Veffel, of his having received the faid Licence fo indorfed as before directed, and to transmit the fame to the Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs in England or Scotland, or to the Commissioners of His Majefty's Revenue in Ireland refpectively, by whom Steph. Cottrell. fuch Licence was granted.
