THE King has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto His Excellency Thomas Earl of Elgin, His Majesty's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary at the Sublime Porte, His Royal Licence and Permission to receive and wear the Insignia of the Order of the Crescent, given to him by the Ottoman Emperor.

Whitehall, August 21, 1802.

The King has also been graciously pleased to give and grant unto His Excellency Sir John Borlase Warren, Baronet, Knight of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Rear-Admiral of the White Squadron of His Majesty's Fleet, and His Majesty's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Court of St. Petersburg, His Royal Licence and Permission to receive and wear the Insignia of the Order of the Crescent, transmitted to him by the Ottoman Emperor:

And also to command, that these His Majesty's Concessions and Declarations, together with the relative Documents, be registered in His College of Arms.
