THE King has been gracioufly pleafed to give and grant unto His Excellency Thomas Earl of Elgin, His Majefly's Ambaflador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary at the Sublime Porte, His Royal Licence and Permiffion to receive and wear the Inlignia of the Order of the Crefcent, given to him by the Ottoman Emperor.

Whitehall, August 21, 1802.

The King has also been graciously pleafed to give and grant unto His Excellency Sir John Borlafe Warren, Baronet, Knight of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Rear-Admiral of the White Squadron of His Majesty's Fleet, and His Majesty's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Court of St. Petersburgh, His Royal Licence and Permission to receive and wear the Infignia of the Order of the Crefcent, transmitted to him by the Ottoman Emperor:

And also to command, that there His Majesty's Concessions and Declarations, together with the relative Documents, be registered in His College of Arms.
