claring His Royal Assent to several Acts agreed upon by
both Houses, do desire the immediate Attendance of the
Honorable House in the House of Peers to hear the Com-
mission read; and the Commons being come thither,
the said Commission, empowering the Lord Arch-
bishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor
of Great Britain, and several other Lords therein
named, to declare and notify the Royal Assent to
the said Act, was read accordingly, and the Royal

ration of Six Weeks after the Commencement of
the next Session of Parliament, the Restrictions con-
