T is this Day ordered by His Majelty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, That no Ships or Veffels, belonging to any of His Majetty's Subjects, be permitted to enter and clear out for any of the Ports of the French or Batavian Republics, or for the Ports of any Country occupied by the Armies of France, until further Order; and His Majefty is further pleafed to order, That a General Embargo or Stop be made on all Ships, belonging to the French and Batavian Republics whatfoever, now within or which hereafter shall come into any of the Ports, Harbours, or Roads, within the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, together with all Perfons and Effects on board the faid Ships and Veffels; but that the utmost Care be taken for the Prefervation of all and every Part of the Cargoes on board any of the faid Ships, fo that no Damage or Embezzlement whatever be fultained; and the Right Honourable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majelty's Treafury, the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the neceffary Directions herein, as to them may refpectively appertain.

nance for His Majelly's Service,) do at any Time, during the Space of Two Months from the Date of this Order in Council, prefume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coaltwife, any Gunpowder or Salt Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or fhip or lade any Gunpowder or Salt Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition. on board any Ship or Veffel in order to transporting the fame into any Parts beyond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coaltwife, without Leave or Permifion in that Behalf firlt obtained from His Majefty or His Privy Council, upon pain of incurring and fuffering the respective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by the aforementioned Act : And the Lords Commiffioners of His Majetty's Treafury, the Commiflioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Maller-General of the Ordnance, and His Majelty's Secretary at War, are to give the neceffary Directions herein, as to them may refpectively appertain. " the Exportation of Naval Stores, and more effec-" tually to prevent the Exportation of Salt Petre, " Arms, and Ammunition, when prohibited by " Proclamation or Order in Council," it is enacted, amongst other Things, That His Majesty may, by Proclamation or Order in Council, when he shall fee Caufe, and for fuch Time as shall be therein exprefied, prohibit the exporting, or the attempting to export, Pig-Iron, Bar-Iron, Hemp, Pitch, Tar, Rofin, Turpentine, Auchors, Cables, Cordage, Maits, Yards, Bowsprits, Oars, Oakum, Oker, Sheet-Copper, and other Naval Stores : And His Majelly, judging it neceffary to prohibit the Exportation of the faid feveral Articles for a limited Time, doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whatfoever do at any Time, during the Space of Two Months from the Date of this Order in Council, prefume to tranfport into any Parts out of this Kingdom any Pig-Iron, Bar-Iron, Hemp, Pitch, Tar, Rolin, Turpin-tine, Anchors, Cables, Cordage, Malts, Yards, Bowfprits, Oars, Oakum, Oker, Sheet-Copper, or other Naval Stores, or do thip or lade any Pig-Iron, Bar-Iron, Hemp, Pitch, Tar, Rofin, Turpentine, Anchors, Cables, Cordage, Malts, Yards, Bowfprits, Oars, Oakum, Oker, Sheet-Copper, or other Naval Stores, on board any Ship or Veffel, in order to transporting the fame into any Parts beyond the Seas, without Leave or Permillion first being had and obtained from His Majefty or His Privy Coun-cil, upon pain of incurring the Forfeitures inflicted by the aforementioned AC: But it is neverthelefs His Majelty's Pleafure, that nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to any of His Majelty's Ships of War, or any other Ships or Veffels or Boats in the Service of His Majefty, or employed or freighted by His Majefty's Board of
