

Twelve Yeomen of the Guards closed the Proceffion.

The Staff-Men entered the Chapel, and paffed Three on each Side of King Henry the Seventh's Tomb, to the Receffes under the East Windows.

The Drums, Kettle-Drums, and Trumpets, divided at the Gate of the Chapel, and formed a Paf-

fage on the Outlide. The Alms-Men entered the Chapel, and having, in the Middle of the Choir, made their Reverences together, first to the Altar, and then to the Sovereign's Stall, paffed Six on each Eide of King Henry the Seventh's Tomb, to the Receffes of the Windows.

The Meffenger, with like Reverences, placed himfelf between the Altar and the Stall of the Junior Knight.

The Efquires, Three and Three, made like Reverences, and flood before their respective Seats.
