The KING's Most Excellent Majefty in Council.

HEREAS the Time limited by His Majefty's Order in Council of the Sixth Day of April last, for prohibiting the Exportation out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coastwile, Gunpowder or Salt Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire upon the Sixth Day of June next : And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majefty's Service, and the Safety of this Kingdom, that the faid Prohibition should be continued for fome Time longer, His Majefty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whatfoever, (except the Mafter-General of the Ordnance for His Majefty's Service,) do at any Time, during the Space of Six Months, to commence from the faid Sixth Day of June next, prefume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coastwife, any Gunpowder or Salt Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or ship or lade any Gunpowder or Salt Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, on board any Ship or Veffel in order to transporting the fame into any Parts beyond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coastwife, without Leave or Permission in that Behalf first obtained from His Majefty or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuffering the respective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by an Act paffed in the Twenty-ninth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled "An the faid Acts in each County, Riding, Stewartry, "Act to empower His Majesty to prohibit the City, and Place respectively: And We do hereby

" Exportation of Salt Petre, and to enforce the " Law for empowering His Majelty to prohibit. " the Exportation of Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition; and alfo to empower " His Majelty to reftrain the carrying Coastwife of " Salt Petre, Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or " Ammunition :"-And the Right Honorable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury, the Commiffioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Mafter-General of the Ordnance, and His Majefty's Secretary at War, are to give the neceffary Directions herein, as to them may refpectively appertain. PROCLAMATION. А For increasing the Militia.

GEORGE R.

7 HEREAS it is expedient that the Number of Our Militia Forces should be increased without Delay : And whereas the Occafion thereof hath been communicated to Parliament : We have thought fit, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, to publish this Our Royal Proclamation; and We do hereby, in purfuance of the Powers which are vefted in Us by an Act paffed in the Forty-fecond Year of Our Reign, intituled "An " Act for amending the Laws relating to the Mi-" litia in England, and for augmenting the Mi-" litia," and of another Act paffed in the fame Year, intituled "An Act to raife and establish a " Militia Force in Scotland," order and direct that, in Addition to the Number of Men already required to be raifed under the faid Acts by the feveral Counties, Ridings, Stewartries, Cities, and Places therein mentioned, there shall forthwith be railed and enrolled in the faid feveral Counties, Ridings, Stewartries, Citics, and Places therein mentioned, respectively, such a Number of Men as may amount to, but not exceed the Proportion of One Half of the whole Number of Men required to be railed by
