A PROCLAMATION,

For granting the Diffribution of Prizes during the prefent Hoftilities.

GEORGE R.

HEREAS, by Our Order in Council, dated the Sixteenth Day of May laft, We have ordered that General Reprifals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of France; and by Our Order in Council, dated the Sixteenth Day of June last, We have ordered that General Reprifals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of the Batavian Republic; fo that as well Our Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Veffels that shall be commissionated by Letters of Marque, or General Reprilais, or otherwife, by Our Commillioners for executing Our Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels, and Goods belonging to France or the Batavian Republic, or any Perfons being Subjects of France or the Batavian Republic, or inhabiting within any of the Territories of France or of the Batavian Republic, and bring the fame to Judgment in any of Our Courts of Admiralty within Our Dominions, duly authorifed and required to take Cognizance thereof: We being defirous to give due Encouragement to all Our faithful Subjects who fhall lawfully feize the fame, and having declared in Council, by Our Order of the Sixteenth Day of June laft, Our Intentions concerning the Diffribution of all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes, and Reprilais of all Ships and Goods during the prefent Holdilities, do now make known to all Our loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern, by this Our Proclamation, by and with the Advice and Confent of Our Privy Council, that Our Will and Pleafure is, that the neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereof is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given to the Takers, (fave and except the Pro- i Eight equal Parts ;

duce of fuch Prizes as are or fhall be taken by Ships or Veffels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service, of Our Commiffioners of Cultoms or Excife, the Difpolition of which We referve to Our further Pleafure, and also fave and except as hereinafter-mentioned,) but fubject to the Payment of all fuch or the like Cultoms and Duties as the fame are now or would have been liable to if the fame were or might have been imported as Merchandize; and that the fame may be fo given in the Proportion and Manner hereinafter fet forth; that is to fay,

That all Prizes taken by Ships and Veffels having Commiffions of Letters of Marque and Reprifals, (fave and except fuch Prizes as are or fhall be taken by the Ships or Veffels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of, Our Commiffioners aforefaid,) may be fold and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others to whom flich Letters of Marque and Reprifals are granted, for their own Ufe and Benefit after final Adjudication, and not before.

And We do hereby further order and direct, that the next Produce of all Prizes which are or shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Veffels of War, (fave and except when they shall be acting on any conjunct Expedition with Our Army, in which Cafe We referve to Ourfelves the Division and Distribution of all Prize and Booty taken ; and alfo fave and except as hereinafter-mentioned,) faali be for the entire Benefit and Encouragement of Our Flag-Officers, Captains, Commanders, and other Commiffioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Seamen, Marines, and Soldiers on board our faid Ships and Veffels at the Time of the Capture; and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fold and difpofed of by them and their Agents after the fame shall have been to Us finally adjudged lawful Prize, and not otherwife.

The Distribution shall be made as follows: The Whole of the neat Produce being first divided into Eight equal Parts:
