# CHARLES PAGET.

SIR, Endymion, at Sea, June 25, 1803. I HAVE the Honor to inform you, that this Morning, in Lat. 47 Deg. 10 Min. North, and Long. 20 Deg. Welt. the Endymion fell in with and captured, after a Chafe of Eight Hours, La Bacchante French Corvette, of Eighteen Twelve-Pounders, commanded by Lieutenant de Vaiffeau Perimel, and having on board Two Hundred Men. La Bacchante is a remarkably tine Ship, of large Dimensions, quite New, and fails very falt. She was on her Return to Breft, having been fent from thence Three Months ago with Difpatches for St. Domingo. The Captain perfifted fo long in his Endeavours to efcape, that the Endymion's Chafe Guns killed her Second Captain and Seven Men, and wounded Nine others. I am happy to add her Fire did us no Harm.
