T the Court at St. James's, the 17th of Argy? 1803,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS in the Countries styling themfelves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, Measures of Hostility have been adopted against His Majesty's Subjects; and whereas the said Countries cannot but be confidered as absolutely dependent on, and under the Controll of, the Government of France; His Majesty is pleased, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that General Reprisals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of the faid Countries styling themselves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, fo that as well His Majesty's Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Vessels that shall be commissionated, by Letters of Marque, or General Reprifals, or otherwife, by His Majesty's Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels, and Goods belonging to the Persons inhabiting the Countries styling themselves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, and bring the fame to Judgment in any of the Courts of Admiralty within His Majesty's Domimions; and, to that End, His Majesty's Advocate-General, and the Advocate of the Admiralty, are forthwith to prepare the Draft of a Commission, and present the same to His Majesty at this Board, authoriting the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, or any Person or Persons by them empowered and appointed, to iffue forth and grant Letters of Marque and Reprifals to any of His Majesty's Subjects, or others whom the faid Commissioners shall deem fitly qualified in that Behalf, for the apprehending, feizing, and taking the Ships, Veftels, and Goods belonging to the Perfons inhabiting the Countries styling themselves the Ligurian

and Italian Republics; and that fuch Powers and Clauses be inscreed in the said Commission as have been usual, and are according to former Precedents; and His Majesty's faid Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty. are also forthwith to prepare the Draft of a Commission, and present the same to His Majesty at this Board, authoriting the faid Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, to will and require the High Court of Admiralty of Great Britain, and the Lieutenant and Judge of the faid Court, his Surrogate or Surrogates, as also the several Courts of Admiralty within His Majesty's Dominions which shall be duly commissionated to take Cognizance of, and judicially proceed upon all and all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes, and Reprifals of all Ships and Goods that are or shall be made, and to hear and determine the same, and according to the Course of Admiralty, and the Laws of Nations, to adjudge and condemn all fuch Ships. Vessels, and Goods as shall belong to the Persons inhabiting the Countries styling themselves the Ligurian and Italian Republics; and that such Powers and Authorities be inferted in the faid Commission as have been usual, and are according to former Precedents; and they are likewife to prepare and lay before His Majesty at this Board a Draft of fuch Instructions as may be proper to be fent to the faid feveral Courts of Admiralty in His Majefty's foreign Governments and Plantations for their Guidance herein; as also another Draft of Instructions for fuch Ships as shall be commisfionated for the Purpoles afore-mentioned.
