PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. WHEREAS in the Countries flyling them-felves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, Measures of Hostility have been adopted against His Majesty's Subjects; and whereas the faid Countries cannot but be confidered as abfolutely dependent on, and under the Controul of, the Govern-ment of France; His Majefty is pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that General Reprifals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of the faid Countries styling themselves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, fo that as well His Majefty's Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Veffels that shall be commissionated, by Letters of Marque, or General Reprifals, or otherwife, by His Majefty's Commiffioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, fhall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels, and Goods belong-ing to the Perfons inhabiting the Countries ftyling themfelves the Ligurian and Italian Republics, and bring the fame to Judgment in any of the Courts of Admiralty within His Majefty's Domi-nions; and, to that End, His Majefty's Ad-vocate-General, and the Advocate of the Ad-miralty, are forthwith to prepare the Draft of a Commiftion, and prefent the fame to His Majefty to this Board authoriting the Commiftioners for at this Board, authorifing the Commiffioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, or any Perfon or Perfons by them empowered and appointed, to iffue forth and grant Letters of Marque and Reprifals to any of His Majefty's Subjects, or others whom the faid Commissioners shall deem fitly qualified in that Behalf, for the apprehending, feizing, and taking the Ships, Vef-fels, and Goods belonging to the Perfons inhabit-ing the Countries flying themfelves the Ligurian and Italian Republics; and that fuch Powers and Claufe he infurted is the first Committee Clauses be inferted in the faid Commission as have been ufual, and are according to former Precedents; and His Majelky's faid Advocate General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are also forthwith to prepare the Draft of a Commillion, and prefent the fame to His Majefty at this

cuting the Office of Lord High Admiral, to will and require the High Court of Admiralty of Great Britain, and the Lieutenant and Judge of the faid Britain, and the Eneutenant and judge of the fail Court, his Surrogate or Surrogates, as alfo the fe-veral Courts of Admiralty within His Majefty's Dominions which shall be duly commissionated to take Cognizance of, and judicially proceed upon all and all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes, and Description of all Shine and Coords that are or fail has Reprifals of all Ships and Goods that are or shall be made, and to hear and determine the fame, and according to the Course of Admiralty, and the Laws of Nations, to adjudge and condemn all fuch Ships, Veffels, and Goods as shall belong to the Perfons inhabiting the Countries styling themselves the Ligurian and Italian Republics; and that such Powers and Authorities be inferted in the faid Commiffion as have been ufual, and are according to former Precedents ; and they are likewife to prepare and lay before His Majefty at this Board a Draft of fuch Infructions as may be proper to be fent to the faid feveral Courts of Admiralty in His Ma-jefty's foreign Governments and Plantations for their Guidance herein; as also another Draft of Infructions for fuch Ships as shall be commif-fionated for the Purpofes afore-mentioned.
