HEREAS the Colony of Berbice has furrended to His Majelty's Arms, and the Territories and Forts of the fame are delivered up to His Majefty, and the faid Colony of Berbice and its Dependencies are now in His Majefty's Poffeffion; His Majefty is thereupon pleafed to order and declare, and it is hereby ordered and declared, That all His Majefty's Subjects may lawfully trade to and from the faid Colony, fubject, neverthelefs, to the same Duties, Rules, Regulations, Conditions, Reftrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures, to which the Trade to and from His Majefty's Colonies, Plantations, and Islands in the West Indies, is or shall be subject by Law: And His Majesty is further pleafed to order and declare, and it is hereby erdered and declared, that all Commodities, being the Growth, Produce, or Manufacture of the faid Colony, being in His Majefty's Poffeffion, shall be permitted to be imported into any of the Ports of this Kingdom in British Ships, owned by His Ma\_ jefty's Suljects, and navigated according to Law, fubject to the fame Duties, Rules, Regulations, Restrictions, Conditions, Penalties, and Forfeitures, as Articles of the like Sort are fubject to, coming from His Majefty's Colonies, Plantations, or Illands in the Weft Indies : And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majelly's Treasury, and the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, are 40 give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may refpectively appertain. mife and declare, that the Bounties of Five Pounds for every Able Seaman, and Two Pounds Ten Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, fit for His Majefty's Service, should be paid in the Manner thereby directed to every fuch Able and Ordinary Seaman, not above the Age of Fifty nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who should, on or before the Thirtieth Day of June then following, enter themfelves to ferve in His Majesty's Royal Navy, either with the Captains or Lieutenants of His Majefty's Ships or Veffels, or Officers employed on Shore for raifing Men for the Service of the Royal Navy : And whereas His Majefty was alfo gracioufly pleafed, by His faid Proclamation, to declare, that all Ablebodied Landmen, not above the Age of Thirtyfive nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who should so enter themselves as aforefaid, should receive the Sum of Thirty Shillings each Man as His Majefly's Royal Bounty : And whereas His Majefty was also gracioufly pleafed, by His Royal Proclamation bearing Date the Seventh Day of March laft, to promife and declare, that a Reward of Twenty Shillings for every A'ble and Ordinary Seaman, fit to ferve on board His Majelty's Ships, should be paid to any Perfon who should difcover any Seaman or Seamen, who might conceal him or themfelves, fo that fuch Seaman or Seamon should be taken for His Majelty's Service, by any of His Majefty's Sea-Officers employed for raifing Mea, on or before the Thirtieth Day of April then next: And whereas the Time limited by the faid Proclamation for Payment of the faid Bountits and Reward hath, by Order in Council, been prolonged and extended to the Thirty-first Day of this inflane December; and it being judged expedient for His Majefty's Service, that the faid Bounties and Reward should be continued to be paid for fome Time longer, His Majefty, with the Advice of His Privy Council, doth therefore order, and it is hereby acpleafed, by His Royal Proclamation bear | cordingly ordered, that the Time limited for Payment of the faid Bounties and Reward be prolonged and extended from the faid Thirty-first. Day of this inftant December to the Thirty-first. Day of December One thousand eight hundred and four inclusive; whereof all Perfons concerned are to take Notice and govern themfelves accordingly. W.
