Whitehall, November 25, 1803.

HE King has been pleased to grant unto William Hunt Prion, of Charlton King's, in the County of Gloucester, Esq; only Son and Heir of Doddington Hunt, late of the same Place, Esq; deceased, by Elizabeth siis Wife, Daughter and sole Heir of William Prinn, late of Charlton King's aforesaid, Esq; also deceased, His Royal Licence aforesaid, Esq; also deceased, His Royal Licence and Authority, that he may continue to use the said Surname of Prim in Addition to that of Hunt; that the same may be so used by his Islue; and that he and they may bear the Arms of Prinn quarterly with Hunt, those of Prinn in the first Quarter, in compliance with the Desire, and in order to testify his grateful and affectionate Respect for the Memory of his said late maternal Grandfather, William Prinn, Esq; such Arms being sirst duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office.

The King has also been pleased to grant unto Edward Dyke, of Syrencot, in the County of Wills, Eso; eldest Son of William Dyke, of the same Place, Esq; by Elizabeth his Wife, Daughter of George Webb Poore, late of Devizes, in the faid County, Gentleman, deceased, His Royal Licence and Authority, that he may allume the Surcence and Authority, that he may assume the Surname of Poore, and bear the Arms of Poore in Addition to those of Dyke; and that such Surname and Arms of Poore may be so taken and used by his Isue, purfuant to an Injunction contained in the last Will and Testament of Edward Poore, late of North Tidworth and Figheldean, in the faid County of Wilts, Esq; deceased, (elder Brother of the said George Webb Poore, and maternal Great Uncle of the faid Edward Dyke,) when and as they shall re-spectively succeed to the Estates thereby devised; fuch Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office:

in Parliament for Chrischurch, in the County of Southampton, only Son and Heir Apparent of John Sturges, Doctor of Laws, One of the Prebendaries of the Cathedral Church of Winchester, Chancellor of that Diocese, and Rector of Alverstoke, in the said County of Southampton, by Judith his late Wise, deceased, Third Daughter of Richard Bourne, formerly of Acton-Hall aforesaid.
