Strasburg, Nov. 30. The apprehenfions which the preparations the French are making in thefe parts give us, are encreafed by the Adviceswerene ceive from France, Flanders, and Holland; from whence feveral hetters have of date told us, that the Freach have a defign upon this City, and that threy will execute it this Winfer; that in order thereunto feveral Troops are marching this way from Flanders, and other part's, and that therefore we ought to bave a watchful eye upon their motions; which advices we doubt not but our Magiffrates make the ufe they oughte of. The Answet cur-Deputies received from the Intendant of Brifac makes us hope that the new Cuftom houfes ehat have been latcly fet up by the French Farmers in feveral places on the Rbine, will be taken awry, which will be otherwite a great vexation to ouf Merchants.
