THEREAS, in virtue of the Powers vefted in His Majefty by an Act paffed in the prefent Seffion of Parliament, intituled "An "Act to continue feveral Laws relating to the "fufpending the Operation of Two Acts of the " Fifteenth and Seventeenth Years of the Reign " of His prefent Majefty, for reftraining the Ne-" gociation of Promillory Notes and Bills of Ex-" change, under a limited Sum, in England; and " the prohibiting the Exportation from, and per-" mitting the Importation, into, Great Britain, "mitting the Importation, into, Great Britain, "of Corn, and for allowing the Importation of "other Articles of Provision, without Payment of "Duty, until the Twenty fifth Day of March "One thousand eight hundred and five; and to "the regulating the Trade and Commerce to and "from the Isle of Malta, until Six Months after "the Ratification of a Definition Treaty of Parace." " the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of Peace;" His Majefty was pleafed, by His Order in Council, bearing Date the Eighth of May laft, to permit, for the Space of Three Months, from the Date of the faid Order, the Importation of fundry Articles of Provisions therein specified Duty free; And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Permiffion should be continued for some Time longer, His Majefty is thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to allow, and doth hereby allow, for and during the Space of Three Months, to commence from the Eighth Day of August next, the Importation into any Port or Place of Great Britain of any Beans called Kidney or French Beans, lares, Lentiles, Calavancies, and all other Sorts of Pulle; and alfo Bulls, Cows, Oxen, Calves, Sheep, Lambs, and Swine; Beef, Pork, Mutton, Veal, and Lamb, whether falted or otherwife; Bacon, Hams, Tongues, Butter. Cheefe, Potatoes, Sago, Sago-Powder, Tapioca, Vermicelli, Millet-Seed, Poultry, Fowls, Eggs, Came, and Sour Crout, in any British Ship or Vessel, or in any other

shall be made of all such Articles as aforelaid, that shall be fo imported, with the proper Officers of the Cuftoms at the Port where the fame shall be imported, under the Penalties and Forfeitures mentioned and referred to in the faid above-recited Act.-And the Right Honorable the Lords Commillioners of His Majefty's Treasury are to give the necessary Directions herein accordingly.

WHEREAS, in virtue of the Powers velted in W HEREAS, in virtue of the rowers veneu in His Majefty by an Act, paffed in the pre-fent Sellion of Parliament, intituled "An Act "for permitting, until the Fifth Day of May One "thousand eight hundred and five, the Importation "of Hides, Calf-Skins, Horns, Tallow, and Wool (except Cotton Wool), in Foreign Ships, on Pay-" ment of the like Duties, as if imported in British " or Irish Ships;" His Majesty was pleased, by His Order in Council, bearing Date the Twenty-third Day of April laît, to permit, for the Space of Three Months from the Date of the faid Order, the Importation in Foreign Ships of any Hides, Pieces of Hides, dreffed or undreffed, Calf-Skins, or Pieces of Calf-Skins, dreffed or undreffed, Horns, or Pieces of Horns, Tallow, and Wool (except Cotton Wool), on the Dutics specified in the faid Order; And whereas it is judged expe-dicat that the faid Permission should be continued for fome Time longer, His Majelly is thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to allow, and doth hereby allow, for and during the Space of Three Months, to commence from the Twenty-third Day of this inftant July, the Importation of any Hides, Pieces of Hides, dreffed or undreffed, Calf-Skins, or Pieces of Calf-Millet-Seed, Poultry, Fowls, Eggs, Came, and Sour Crout, in any British Ship or Vessel, or in any other Ship or Vessel belonging to Perfons of any King dom or State in Amity with His Majesty, and navi-gated in any Manner whatever, witkout Payment of any Foreign Ship or Vessel with any of the Articles
