THE King has been pleased to cause it to be signified by the Right Honorable Lord Harrowby, His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, to the Ministers of Neutral Powers residing at this Court, that the necessary Measures have been taken, by His Majesty's Command, for the Blockade of the Entrance of the Ports of Fecamp, St. Vallery en Caux, Dieppe, Treport, The Somme, Etaples, Boulogne, Calais, Gravelines, Dunkirk, Neuport, and Ostend; and that from this Time all the Measures authorized by the Law of Nations, and the respective Treaties between His Majesty and the different Neutral Powers, will be adopted and executed with respect to all Vessels which may attempt to violate the said Blockade.
