Copy of a Letter from Admiral Lord Gardner, Commander in Chief of His Majesty's Ships and Vessels on the Coast of Ireland, to William Marsden, Esq; dated at Cork, the 2d Instant.

SIR,

I AM to desire you will please to acquaint the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, that His Majesty's Ship Topaze, arrived here this Morning, with La Minerve French Letter of Marque Ship belonging to Bourdeaux, bound to Martinique, pierced for Eighteen Guns Nine-Pounders, Fourteen only mounted, with One Hundred and Eleven Officers and Men on board; which the Topaze fell in with on the 25th Ult. in Latitude 49 Deg. 30 Min. N. and Longitude 15 Deg. W.
