Copy of a Letter from Captain Major Jacob Henniker, of His Majefly's Sloop the Albacore, to William

Marsden, Esq; dated the 17th Inflant.

SIR,

BEG Leave to transmit to you, for the Informa-tion of my Lords Commillioners of the Admiralty, a Copy of my Letter to Rear-Admiral Sir James Saumarez, Bart. of this Date. " I find it my Duty to acquaint you, that Yester-

day, the 16th, in proceeding from Granville-Bay, in purfuance of your Orders, at the Diftance of Three Miles I had an Opportunity of observing the Five Flotilla driven on Shore on the 9th Ult. by His Majetty's Sloop under my Command, and af-certained that they were all fill there, fwamped and bilged, with a heavy Sea and tremendous Surf breaking violently over them."
