fey, Jerley, Alderney, Sark, or Man, from Charlef- Cornet J. Wallinger to be Lieutenant, without Pur-town, in the State of South Carolina; from the Town chale. of Darien, in the State of Georgia; or from New Orleans, in the Territory of Louifiana; or from any Port within the faid States of South Carolina and Georgia, or the Territory of Louifiana, and shall have cleared out from any of the faid Ports or Places fubfequent to the First Day of September last, (nor having any Person or Persons on board the fame ill of the said infectious Distemper,) do personn a Quarantine of Fifreen Days, at the feveral Places appointed, and according to the Rules prefcribed, by His Majefty's Orders in Council of the Twenty-ninth of July One thousand eight hundred, and of this Date, for Performance of Quarantine by all Ships and Veffels coming from or through the Mediter ranean, or from the West Barbary on the Atlantic Ocean, or from any Port or Place on the Coast of Spain, without the Streights of Gibraltar, to the Southward of Cape St. Vincent, and arriving with clean Bills of Health; but in cafe it. shall appear upon the Arrival of any Ship or Vessel at any of the Ports of Great Britain, or of the Islands aforefaid, which shall have cleared out subsequent to the faid First Day of September last from any of the Forts or Places before mentioned within the Territory of the United States of America; that any of the Crew or Paffengers belonging to the fame, are actually ill of fuch infectious Diftemper. or any of the Crew or Paffengers on board any fuch Ship or Veffel shall have died of the faid infectious Diltem-per, or have been ill of the fame, during the Courfe of the Voyage, the Clothes and all perforal Effects, which are fulceptible of Infection, worn by, or be-longing to fuch Perfor, thall be forthwith burned, or funk in deep Water; and the faid Ship or Veffel, with the Whole of her Cargo, shall not be permitted to perform Quarantine at any Port or Place, except at Standgate Creek, and shall be compelled to depart from any other Port or Place, at which the fame has arrived, or shall arrive as aforefaid, and shall repair to Standgate Creek, and there perform Quarantine, and not elfewhere; and be fubject to all the Rules and Regulations to which Ships and Veffels coming from or through the Mediterranean, or from Cadiz, or other Ports of Spain, without the Streights of Gibraltar, to the Southward of Cape St. Vincent, and not furnished with clean-Bills of Health, are fubject : - And the Right Honorable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majelty's Treatury, the Commif-fioners for executing the Office of Lord High Ad-miral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Malter General, and the reft of the principal Officers of the Ordnance, His Ma-jefty's Secretary at War, and the Governors, or Commanders in Chief for the Time being, of the Isles of Guernfey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark, and Man, are to give the necessary Directions herein, as to them may respectively appertain.
