## By the KING. A PROCLAMATION, For a General Faft.

GEORGE R. W.E. taking into Our molt ferious Confideration the juft and neceffary War in which We are engaged, and putting Our Truft in Almighty God that He will graciously bless Our Arms, both by Sea and Land, have resolved, and do, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, hereby command, That a public Day of Fasting and Humiliation be observed throughout those Parts of Our United Kingdom called England and Iraland, or Wadaef Kingdom called England and Ireland, on Wednefday the Twentieth Day of February next enfuing, that so both We and Our People may humble Our-felves before Almighty God, in order to obtain Pardon of Our Sins, and in the most devout and folemn Manner fend up Our Prayers and Suppli-cations to the Divine Majelty, for averting those heavy Judgments which Our manifold Provocatious have most justly deferved; and for imploring His Bleffing and Atliftance on Our Arms for the Restoration of Peace, and Profperity to Us and Our Do-minions: And We do drictly charge and command, that the faid Public Falt be reverently and devoutly observed by all Our loving Subjects in England and Ireland, as they tender the Favour of Almighty God, and would avoid His Wrath and Indignation; -and upon Pain of fuch Punifhment as We may juftly inflict on all fuch as contemn and neglect the Perinflict on all fuch as contenn and neglect the Per-formance of foreligious and neceffary a Duty: And, for the better and more orderly folemnizing the fame, We have given Directions to the Moit Re-werend the Archbifhops, and the Right Reverend the Bifhops of England and Ireland, to compose a Form of Prayer fuitable to this Occasion, to be used in all Churches, Chapels, and Places of Public Worship, and to take Care that the same be timely dispersed throughout their respective Diocefes.

Given at Our Court, at the Queen's Palace, this Second Day of January Oue thousand eight hundred and five, in the Forty-fifth Year of Our Reign.

TTE, taking into Our moft ferious Confideration VV the just and necessary War in which We are engaged, and putting Our Trust in Almighty God that He will gracioully blefs Our Arms, both by Sea and Land, have refolved, and do, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Council, hereby command, That a public Day of Fafting and Humiliation be observed throughout that Part of Our Kingdom of Great Britain called Scotland, on Thursday the Twenty first Day of February next enfuing, that fo both We and Our People may humble Ourfelves before Almighty God, in order to obtain Pardon of Our Sins, and, in the most devout and solemn Manner, fend up Our Prayers and Supplications to the Divine Majefty, for averting those heavy Judgments which Our manifold Provocations have most justly deferved; and for imploring His Bleffing and Af-fiftance on Our Arms, for the Reftoration of Peace, and Prosperity to Us and Our Dominions : And We do strictly charge and command, That the faid public Fast be reverently and devoutly observed by all Our loving Subjects in Scotland, as they tender the Favour of Almighty God, and would avoid His Wrath and Indignation ; and upon Pain of fuch. Punilhment as We may justly inflict on all fuch as contemn and neglect the Performance of fo religious and neceffary a Duty : Our Will is, therefore, and We charge, That this Our Proclamation feen, ye forthwith proceed to the Market Crofs of Edinburgh, and all other Places needful, and there, in Our Name and Authority, make Publication hereof, that none pretend Iguorance: And Our Will and Pleasure is, That Our Solicitor do cause printed Copies hercof to be fent to the Sheriffs of the feveral Shires, Stewarts of Stewartries, and Bainiffs of Regalities, and their Clerks, whom We ordain to fee the fame published; and We do appoint them to fend Copies hereof to the feveral Parish Churches within their Bounds, and that, upon the Lord's Day immediately preceding the Day above-mentioned,
