PRESENT,

The KING's Molt Excellent Majefty in Council. 7HEREAS, in virtue of the Powers wifted in His Majefty by an Act, paffed in the last Seffion of Parliament, intituled " An Act "for permitting, until the Fifth Day of May One " thousand eight hundred and five, the Importation . " of Hides, Caif Skins, Horns, Tallow, and Wool " (except Cotton Wool), in Foreign Ships, on Pay-. " ment of the like Duties, as if imported in British " or Irifh Ships;" His Majefty was pleafed, by His . Order in Council, bearing Date the Twentieth Day of September One thouland eight hundred and four, to permit, for the Space of Three Months, to commence from the Twenty-ilurd Day . of October laft, the Importation in Foreign Ships of any Hides, Pieces of Hides, dreffed or un-. dreffed, Calf-Skins, or Pieces of Calf-Skins, dreffed or undressed, Horns, or Pieces of Horns, Tallow, and Wool (except Cotton Wool), on the Duties Decified in the faid Order; And whereas it is judged expedient that the daid Permillion should be continued for fome Time longer, His Majefty is ; thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to allow, and doth hereby allow, for , and during the Space of Three Months, to commence from the Twenty-third Day of this Inflant, the Importation of any Hides, Pieces of Hides, dreffed or undreffed, Calf-Skins, or Pieces of Calf-Skins, dreffed or undreffed, Horas, or Pieces of Horns, Tallow, and Wool (except Cotton Wool), in any Foreign Ship or Veffel ; and that on the Arrival at any Port of the United Kingdom of any Foreign Ship or Veffel with any of the Articles above mentioned, the faid Goods shall be admitted to Entry on Payment of the fame Duties of Cultoms and Excife as are due and payable on the like + Goods when imported in any British or Irish-built

The KING's Most Excellent Majelty in Council.

WHEREAS His Majelty has received Infor-VV mation that the King of Spain has iffued a Declaration of War against His Majesty, His Subjects, and People.; His Majelty, therefore, being determined to take fuch Measures as are necessary for vindicating the Honor of His Crown, and for the vivorous Protecution of the War in which He finds himself engaged, is pleased, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that General Reprisals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of the King of Spain, fo that as well His Majefty's Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Velfels that shall be commissionated, by Letters of Marque, or General Reprifals, or otherwife, by His Majeity's Commiffioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels, and Goods belonging to the King of Spain, or his Subjects, or others inhabiting within the Territories of the King of Spain, and bring the fame to Judgment in any of the Courts of Admiralty within His Majefty's Dominions; and, to that End, His Majefty's Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are forthwith to prepare the Draft of a Com-miffion, and prefent the fame to His Majefty at this Board, authorifing the Commiffioners for exe-cuting the Office of Lord High Admiral, or any Person or Persons by them empowered and appointed, to iffue forth and grant Letters of Marque and Reprifals to any of His Majefty's Subjects, or others whom the faid Commissioners shall deem fitly qualified in that Behalf, for the apprehending, feizing, and taking the Ships, Veffels, and Goods belonging to Spain, and the Vaffals and Subjects of the King of Spain, or any inhabiting within His
