An Act to repeal to much of an Act paffed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, initialed An Act to reftrain the Difposition of Lands whereby the fame become unalienable, as reitrains Colleges within the Two Universities of Oxford and Cambridge from purchasing or holding Advowsons except as therein is provided.

An Ast for appointing additional Commissioners for the better examining and auditing certain of the public Accounts of Great Britain.

An Act to amend Two Acts of the Thirteenth and Forty fourth Years of His prefent Majefty for the more effectual Execution of the Criminal Laws, and more eafy apprehending and bringing to Trial. Offenders elcaping from one Part of the United Kingdom to the other, and from one County to another.

An Act to amend and render more effectual an Act made in the Parliament of Ireland in the Fifth Year of His prefent Majefty, intituled An Act for erecting and eftablishing public Infirmaries or Hospitals in this Kingdom.

An Act to continue the Proceedings in the Houfe of Lords touching the Conduct of Luke Fox, Efquire, one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of that Part of the United Kingdom called Ireland, notwith!tanding any Prorogation or Diffolution of Parliament.

An Act to revive and continue an Act made in the Thirty-firlt Year of His prefent Majefty, inti tuled in Act for the Encouragement of the Pilchard Fifhery, by allowing a further Bounty upon Pilchards taken, cured, and exported.

An Act for granting a certain Sum of Money towards improving the Harbour on the North Side of the Hill of Howth, near Dublin, and rendering it a fit Situation for His Majefty's Packets.

An Act to appoint Commissioners to enquire and examine into any Irregularities or Abufes which

may have taken place in conducting and managing the paving, cleanfing, and lighting the Streets of Dublin; and to provide for the Sufpenfion of the Powers and Authorities of the Corporation of Directors and Commiffioners for paving, cleanfing, and lighting the faid Streets; and for verting the fame in other Perfons during fuch Sufpenfion, and for the better conducting and managing the Bufinefs of the faid Corporation.

An Act for repealing an Act made in the Fortyfourth Year of His prefent Majetty, intituled Au Act for better governing, maintaining, and employing the Poor of the Parish of Saint Pancras, in the County of Middlelex; for providing a new Workhouse for the Use of the faid Parish; for appointing Collectors of the Rates, and for other Purposes therein mentioned; and for making more effectual Provision for those and other Purposes.
