Copy of a Letter from Sir Robert Calder, Bart. Vice-Admiral of the Blue, to the Honorable William Corn-wallis, Admiral of the White, Sc. dated on board His Majesty's Ship the Prince of Wales, the 25th of July 1805.

SIR

AM induced to fend, by the Windfor Caftle, a Triplicate of my Difpatch of the 23d Inftant.
