Copy of a Letter from Sir Robert Calder, Bart. Vice-Admiral of the Blue, to the Honorable William Cornwallis, Admiral of the White, &c. dated on board His Majesty's Ship the Prince of Wales, the 25th of July 1805.

SIR,

I AM induced to send, by the Windsor Castle, a Triplicate of my Dispatch of the 23d Instant. Owing to a very great Omission of my Secretary, who, from Indisposition, and an Interlineation in my first Letter, neglected to insert the Name of Rear-Admiral Charles Stirling in my public Thanks; I am therefore to request you will be pleased to cause the Mistake to be corrected as early as possible.
