Quarters of the Royal Marines eftablished at Portfmouth, Plymouth, or Chatham, or to any Recruit-ing Party of Our faid Forces; and We do hereby declare, that all Seamen and Royal Marines, fo fur-rendering themfelves as aforefaid, shall be released and difcharged from all Profecutions, Imprilonments, and Penalties, commenced or incurred by reafon of any fuch Offences, but that fuch Pardon' shall not entitle Deferters, whether Seamen or Marines, to any Arrears of Pay forfeited by fuch Defertion ; and We do hereby further declare, that all fuch Deferters, whether Seamen or Marines, who fhall not, on or before the faid Tenth Day of Oetober next, furrender themfelves on board. One of Our Ships or Veffels of War, or at the Head-Quarers of the Royal Marines established at Portsmouth, Plymouth, or Chatham, or to fome Recruiting. Party of the faid Forces, or who shall hereafter ab-fent themselves from the Ships to which they belong, or from the Marine Quarters, without Leave from their Commanding Officers, shall be tried at a Court Martial, and, being found guilty, shall be deemed unfit Objects of Our Royal Mercy, and shall fuffer the Punishment of Death, or such other Punishment as they shall be condemned to fuffer by Sentence of the faid Court.

Given at Our Court at Weymouth, the Fiftrenth Day of August, One thousand eight hundred and five, and in the Forty-fifth Year of Our Reign.

. The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

IT is this Day ordered by His Majefty, with the Advice of His Privy Council, that from and after the First Day of December next, or upon the Publication of a Proclamation to that Effect within each Colony, it shall not be lawful, except by special Licence as hereinafter-mentioned, for any Slave or Slaves to be landed upon any of the Coalts, or im-ported or brought into any of the Ports, Harbours, Creeks, or Roads, or within the Limits, Jurifdic-tions, and Territories of any of the Settlements, Iflands, Colonies, or Plantations on the Continent of America, or in the Welt Indies, which have been furrendered to His Majefty's Arms during the prefent War, until further Order, upon Pain that all Slaves fo landed, imported, or brought, contrary to the true Intent and Meaning of this Order, together with the Veffels bringing in the fame, or from which the fame shall be landed, and their Cargoes, shall become forscited to His Majesty, His Helrs, and Succeffors : But whereas it may be expedient to permit the Annual Introduction of a limited Number of Slaves, under due Regulations, for the Purpole of fupplying any Wafte that shall take place in the; Population on particular Estates from extraordinary or unavoidable Caufes, and thereby of keeping up. the Cultivation of the Lands already cleared and cultivated; it is therefore ordered, that any Number of Slaves, not exceeding Three for every Hundred of the whole Number of Slaves in the faid Settle-

ments, Illands, Colonies, and Plantations respectively, (Returns of the Number whereof shall be made from Time to Time, in purfuance of Instructions to be traisfmitted by One of Our Principal Secretaries of State,) may be imported in each Year, (provided Calualtics to that Extent shall appear to have taken place in the preceding Year,) under Licences to be previoufly granted by the Go-vernor, Lieutenant-Governor. or Officer administering the Government of the faid Settlements, Islands, Colonies, and Plantations, from any other of His-Majesty's Colonies in the West Indies, into the faid Settlements, Islands, Colonics, and Plantations re-fpectively; fuch Licence, or a Copy thereof, to be produced by the Master of the Ship on which fuch Slaves are laden, as his Authority for having Slaves on board deftined to the Settlements, &c. as aforefaid : Provided always, that, until the First Day of January, One thousand eight hundred and feven. fuch limited Importation may be made from other Places than His Majefty's Colonies in the West Indies as aforefaid, and without its being necessary for the Master of the Vessel, if met with at Sca, to produce the faid Licence, or a Copy thereof, as his Authority for having the faid Slaves, deltined as aforelaid, on board; but subject, nevertheles, to fuch Licence being first had and obtained as aforefaid, before any Slaves shall be permitted to be landed or fold from fuch Veffel in any of the faid Settlements: And whereas fpecial inftructions will be immediately transmitted by One of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State to the Governors, Lieutenant-Governors, or Officers administering the Government of the faid Colonies, Settlements, and Plantations respectively, containing the Regulations proper for carrying this Order into effectual Execution, directing and empowering them to grant Lif-cences for the Importation of fuch limited Numbers of Slaves as aforefaid, fubject to fuch Regulations as in the faid Instructions will be provided :- It is His Majesty's further Order, that such Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or other Officer as aforefaid, shall be, and they are hereby respectively authorized and empowered to grant fuch Licences, upon fuch Terms and Conditions, and fubject to fuch Regulations, as, in Conformity to, and in Furtherance of, the Object of fuch Instructions, may, from Time to Time, be required ; -- and it is hereby further or-dered, that the Prohibition hereinbefore contained fhall not extend to prevent the importing and landng of any Slaves which shall be imported into the faid Colonies, Iflands, and Plantations by Licence first had for importing the fame, under the Hand and Seal of His Majefty's Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Officer administering the Government of the Colony, Settlement, or Plantation into which fuch Slaves are to be imported, specifying the Ship or Veffel permitted to import the fame, in Conformity with the Inflructions to be received from One of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State as aforefaid; But that all Slaves, except fuch Slaves as may form Part of the Crew of any Veffels, or may be Household Servants to the Passengers therein, which thall be landed without fuch Licence as aforefaid, and without conforming to fuch Regulations as shall be contained therein, shall, together with the Veffels bringing the fame, or from which the fame shall be landed, and their Cargoes, become forfeited to His Majefty, His Heirs, and Succeffors.
