Whitehall, September 14, 1805. HE King has been pleased to grant to His, Royal Highness Frederick Duke of York and Albany the Office of Keeper of His Majesty's Forrests and Warren of Windsor, as also the Office of

Lieutenant of the faid Forest, in the Room of His Royal Highness the Duke of Gloucester, deccased.

The King has also been pleased to constitute and appoint His Royal Highness Frederick Duke of York and Albany to be Warden and Keeper of the New Forest, in the County of Southampton, and also of the Manor and Park of Lindhurst, and the Hundred of Rudbergh, in the Room of His Royal Highness the Duke of Gloucester, deceased.

The King has been pleased to grant unto James Ross, Esq; a Captain in the Royal Navy, and Catherine his Wife, only Daughter and sole Heir of James Farquharfon, late of Invercauld, in the County of Aberdeen, Esq; deseased, His Royal Licence and Authority that they and their Issue may take and use the Surname and bear the Arms of Farquharfon, of Invercauld only, in compliance with an Injunction contained in a Deed of Entail executed by the said James Farquharson, and bearing Date the 27th Day of February 1788; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office:
