Admiralty-Office, September 21, 1805. Copy of a Letter from the Honorable William Corn-wallis, Admiral of the White, to William Marfden, . Efq; dated Ville de Paris, off Ufhant, the 17th . September 1805.

SIR,

HAVE the Honor to acquaint the Lords Com-miffioners of the Admiralty, that His Majefty's Ship Amazon, has this Moment rejoined me; and I enclose, for their Lordships' Information. a Letter from Captain Parker, giving an Account of his kaving fallen in with, and captured the Principé de La Paz Spanish Corvette Privateer.

His Majefly's Ship Amazon, off Ufhant, SIR, 17th September 1805. T BEG to acquaint you, we fell in with the Home-ward bound Jamaica Fleet at Sunfet, on the 31ft August, during a hard North-Weft Gale, Eighty Leagues to the Westward of Scilly, and having with force Difficulty learnt from one of the Convoy that feveral of the Fleet had feverated I Convoy, that feveral of the Fleet had feparated, I judged it proper to continue on the Station directed in your Order, in Hopes of collecting and affording Protection to the Stragglers; we have not met any, but I am happy to inform you, on the 12th Inflant, in Lat. 49 Deg. 50. Min. N. and Long. 18 Deg. 30 Min. W. His Majefty's Ship under my . Command, captured the Principé de la Paz, a Spanish Corvette Privateer, carrying Twenty-four Nine-Pounders and Four Brass Swivels, with One Hun-- dred and Sixty Men on board, principally French.

This Ship was fitted out at Vigo Five Weeks before, and had taken the Prince of Wales Packet from Lifbon, and the Lady Nelfon Letter of Marque, from Virginia bound to Giafgow. We found Part of the Crew of the latter Ship on board the Privateer, and a confiderable Sum in Specie.

-I have much Satisfaction in her Capture, as the was completely flored for remaining Two. Months longer at Sea, and her Captain, François Beck, an experienced Cruifer, who commanded the French Privateer Le Brave, during the late War, greatly to the Annoyance of our Trade.

Copy of a Letter from Vice Admiral Sir Andrew Mit-chell, K. B. Commander in Chief of His Majefly's Ships and Veffels at Halifax, to William Marfden, Efg; dated at Halifax, the 21fl of August 1805. SIR,

HAVE the Honor to enclose, for the Informa-L tion of the Lords Commissioners of the Admi-ralty, Three Letters from Captain Beresford, of His Majefty's Ship Cambrian, flating the Capture of Two of the Enemy's Privateers; also the cutting out of St. Mary's River a Ship, Brig, and a Spanish Schooner Privateer; by which their Lordships will observe with what Coolness and Bravery that Service was conducted under the Direction of Lieutenant George Pigot, and fo ably fupported by Lieutenant Mafterman, of the Royal Marines; in fhort, the fteady Conduct of both Petty Officers, Seamen, and Marines was fuch, as merits my warmeft Thanks and Commendation ; and I beg Leave, most strongly, to recommend them to their Lordships' Notice.

His Majefly's Ship Cambrian, in Lat. 29 Deg. SIR, Long. 62 Beg. June 1.3, 1805. THIS Day Licutenant Pigot had the Direction of the Cambrian's Boats. With the Launch he most gallantly boarded the Spanish Privateer Schooner Maria, of Fourteen Guns and Sixty Men. Lieutenant Crofton, in the Barge, inflantly followed him; the Veffel was carried notwithstanding every Refiltance was made. The other Boats did not get on board until she furrendered ; but no lefs Merit is due to the Officers and Men, who all volunteered this Service. Lieutenant Pigot tells me every one did his Duty most cheerfully. Two excellent Men were killed, and Two wounded.
