PROCLAMATION for pardoning Deferters from His Majesty's Regular Forces. War-Office, October 8, 1805.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the King, that there are, at this Time, several Deserters from His Majesty's Regular Land Forces

who might be induced to return to their Duty by an Offer of His Ma-London. jefty's gracious Pardon, and that fuch Bedford. an Instance of His Royal Clemency would have a due Instuence upon Ipswich. Maidslone. Exeter. their future Behaviour; His Majesty has been graciously pleased to grant His Free Pardon to all Deserters from His Regular Land Forces Marlborough. Southampton. Hereford. who shall surrender themselves, on or before the Eighth Day of De-Shrewfoury. Birmingham. cember next, to any of His Majesty's Nottingham. Leeds. Civil Magistrates, to the Command. ing Officer of any Regiment, to any of the Superintending Field Officers of the Recruiting Service, whose Carlifle, Durbam. Edinburgh. Glafgow. Stations are mentioned in the Margin hereof, or to the Inspector-General of Aberdeen. Inverness. the Recruiting Service in the Isle of

Such Deferters, if able bodied Mcn, and fit for Service, shall be appointed to such Regiments as His Majelly may be pleased to command, and, when so placed, shall not be liable to be claimed by any other Corps to which they may formerly have belonged.

Every Deferter not actually serving in any of His Majesty's Regiments is to surrender himself for General Service.

Deferters ferving in other Corps, (Militia, and Army of Reserve excepted,) are to continue therein upon declaring themselves to their respective Commanding Officers, who are to report the Circumstance to the Secretary at War and the Adjutant General, and they shall not be liable at any future Time, to be claimed by the Regiments in which they formerly served: but this Clause is not to extend to Deservers enlisted by the Corps for raising Recruits for general Service, which Deservers are only to be entitled to their Pardon, on declaring themselves to be such, and will be transferred to such Regiments as His Majesty may be pleased to command.

The Magistrate to whom any Deserter from His Majesty's Regular Forces may surrender himself, is authorised and required to certify the Day on which such Deserter surrendered himself, which Certificate is to continue in force until the Arrival of the Deserter at the Head-Quarters of the nearest Military Post, provided he proceed at the Rate of Ten Miles a Day, unless prevented by Sickness, to be certified by some Medical Practitioner on the Back of the Magistrate's Certificate, or to be otherwise proved to the Satisfaction of the Officer commanding at such Military Post.

No Soldier who may desert after these His Majesty's gracious Intentions are made public, shall be included in the above Pardon, but be proceeded against with the utmost Severity. Nor shall any Soldier who surrendered himself upon any former Proclamation of His Majesty's Pardon, and who afterwards again deserted, be included in the above Pardon. And it is to be clearly understood, that this Pardon is not to extend to any Deserter from His Majesty's Militia Forces, or from the Army of Reserve, or Additional Force; but all Soldiers who shall have enlisted for general Service from the said Forces, and shall subsequently thereto have deserted, will be included in this His Majesty's gracious Pardon.
