Power and Influence of France have been fo unhappily extended, require the Continuance of all poffible Vigilance and Exertion. Under this Imprefion, His Majesty trusts that your Attention will be invariably directed to the Improvement of those Means which are to be found in the Bravery and Discipline of His Forces, in the Zeal and Loyalty of every Clafs of His Subjects, and in the unexhaufted Refources of His Dominions, for rendering the Britilh Empire invincible at Home, as well as formidable Abroad; fatisfied that, by fuch Efforts alone, the Contest can be brought to a Conclusion confistent with the Safety and Independence of the Country, and with its Rank amonght the Nations of the World.
