SIR,

I TRANSMIT herewith, for the Information of their Lordships, the Copy of a Letter from Captain Coghlan, acquainting me of the Capture of the Bellona Schooner Privateer by His Majesty's Sloop Renard.

His Majesty's Sloop Renard, Port Royal Harbour, November 21, 1805.

SIR,

I HAVE the Pleasure to acquaint you with the Capture of the French Privateer Schooner Bellona, on the 11th Ultimo, by this Ship, after a long Chace and some Firing, at the North Side of St. Domingo. She has Four Carriage Guns and Fifty Men; was Seven Days from Barracona, had taken One American Brig. She is only Four Months old, and is considered the fastest sailer out of Cuba.
