Dublin Cafle, March 28, 1806.

The Duke of Bedford, who embarked at Holy. head on Tuefday Night the 25th Inftant, on board His Majelty's Yacht the Dorfet, arrived in this Harbour early this Morning.

His Grace on his Arrival in Dublin, was received by the Lord Mayor, Aldermen, Sheriffs, and Commons of the City of Dublin. His Grace, attended by a Squadron of Dragoons, proceeded to the Caltle, and the Council having affembled at Three o'Clock, His Grace was introduced in form to His Excellency the Earl of Hardwicke, who received him fitting under the Canopy of State in the Prefence Chamber, from whence a Proceffion was made in the ufual State to the Council Chamber: The Council fitting, His Grace's Commiffion was read, and the Oath being administered to him, His Grace was invefted with the Collar of the moft illuftrious Order of Saint Patrick, and received the Sword of State from the Earl of Hardwicke.

His Grace afterwards repaired to the Prefence Chamber, and received the Compliments of the Nobility and other Perfons of Diftinction upon his fafe Arrival, and taking upon him the Government of Ireland.
