AT the Court at the Queen's Palace, the 17th of September 1806;

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majefty in Council. 7 HEREAS by an A& made and paffed in the VV laft Seffion of the prefent Parliament, and in the prefent Year of His Majelty's Reign, intituled " An Act for authorizing His Majefty in Council to allow, during the prefent War, and for Six Months after the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of Peace, the Importation and Exportation of certain Goods and Commodities in Neutral Ships into, and from His Majefty's Territories in the Weft Indies and Continent of South America;" It is enacted, That from and after the paffing of the faid Act, it fhall and may be lawful for His Majefly, His Heirs and Succeffore, by and with the Advice of His and Their Privy Council, to permit, or to authorize the Governors of the Islands and Terri-tories hereinafter mentioned, in such Manner, and under fuch Reftrictions as to His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, shall feem fit, to permit, when the Necessity of the Cafe shall appear to His Majesty, with the Advice of His Privy Council to require it, from Time to Time during the prefent War, and for Six Months after the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of Peace, the Importation into, and the Exportation from, any Island in the West Indies, (in which Defcription the Bahama Islands and the Bermuda or Somer Islands are included,) or any Lands or Territories on the Continent of South America to His Majelly belonging, of any fuch Articles, Goods, and Commodities as shall be mentioned in such Order of His Majetty in Council, in any Ships or Veffels belonging to the Subjects of any State in Amity with His Majefly, in fuch Manner as His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors, by and with the Advice aforefaid, thall direct; provided fuch Ships or Veffels shall duly enter into, report, and deliver their refpective Cargoes, and reload at fuch Ports only, where regular Cuitom-Houfes shall have been established :

And whereas it appears at prefent to be necef-fary to permit, for a limited Time, fubject to be fooner terminated, varied, or altered, as is hereinafter provided, the Importation into, and Exportation from the Iflands and Territories of His MajeRy in the Welt Indies, (including the Bahama Iflands and the Bermuda or Somer Iflands,) and the Lands and Territories on the Continent of South America to His Majelly belonging, of certain Articles, Goods, and Commodities hereinafter mentioned, in any Ships or Veffels belonging to the Subjects of any State in Amity with His Majelly ; His Majelly is thereupon pleafed by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and doth hereby order, that the Governors and Lieutenant-Governors of His Majetty's Iflands and Colonies in the Wett Indies, (in which Defeription the Bahama Islands and the Bermuda or Somer Islands, are included,) and of any Lands or Territories on the Continent of South America to His Majefty belonging, and seach and every of fuch Governors and Lieutenant-Governors shall be authorized, and they, and each

and every of them are hereby authorized to permit for Twelve Months from the Date hereof, fubject to be fooner terminated, varied, or altered as is here. inafter provided, in any Ships or Veffels belonging to the Subjects of any State in Amity with His Majefty, the Importation into the faid Iflands, Colonies, Lands and Territories refpectively, of Staves, and Lumber, and also of every Kind of Provisions (Beef, Pork, and Butter always excepted,) which are of the Growth or Produce of the Country to which fuch Ship or Veffel importing the fame, shall belong; and allo the Exportation from the faid Islands, Colonies, Lands and Territories refpectively, into which fuch Importation of Staves, Lumber, and Provisions as aforefaid, shall be made, of Rum and Molaffes, and of any other Articles, Goods, and Commodities whatfoever, except Sugar, Indigo, Cotton Wool, Coffee, and Cocoa; provided always, that fuch Ships or Veffels shall duly enter into, report, deliver their respective Cargoes, and reload at fuch Ports only where regular Custom Houles shall have been established : And His Majetty, by and with the Advice of His faid Privy Council, is further pleafed to order, and doth hereby order, that notwithstanding any thing hereinbefore contained, the faid Permission and Authority to import and export, shall cease and determine, or be varied and altered before the Expiration of the above mentioned Period of Twelve Months, at the Expiration of Six Months after Notification in the London Gazette of any Order of His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, for revoking, varying, or altering fuch Permission or Authority, or shall cease and determine at the Expiration of Six Months after the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of W. Fawkener. Peace.

PRESENT,

The KING's Moft Excellent Majefty in Council. HEREAS His Majefty was pleafed, by His W Order in Council, bearing Date the Fifth Day of April, One thousand eight hundred and five, to direct that the Quarantine laid by His Majelty's Order of the fame Date upon all Ships and Veffels, as well His Majesty's Ships of War as all others, not having the Plague or other infectious Difeafe or Diftemper actually on board, coming from or through the Mediterranean, with Clean Bills of Health, fhould be extended to all Ships and Veffels as aforefaid coming from the Port of Cadiz, or from any other Port of Spain without the Streights of Gi-braltar, lying to the Southward of Cape St. Vincent: And whereas there does not at prefent appear to be any Reafon to apprehend that there does exift any unufual or infectious Diflemper in any Part of Spain ; His Majefty is thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to revoke and difcharge, and doth hereby revoke and difcharge the faid Order of the Fifth Day of April, One thoufand eight hundred and five ; and His Majefty doth hereby order, that all fuch Ships and Veffels as aforefaid be permitted to difcharge their refpective Lading without unpacking, opening, and airing, and without performing Quarantine, as freely as they might have done in cafe fuch Order of the Fifth Day of April,
