A PROCLAMATION.

GEORGE R.

WHEREAS Gur Parliament ftands prorogued to Wednefday the Twenty-ninth Day of this inftant October, We, with the Advice of Our Privy Council, do hereby publifh and declare, that the faid Parliament fhall be further prorogued, on the faid Twenty-ninth Day of this inftant October, to Thurfday the Twenty-leventh Day of November next; and We have given Order to Our Chancellor of that Part of Our United Kingdom called Great Britain, to prepare a Commiffion for proroguing the fame accordingly : And We do further hereby, with the Advice aforefaid, declare Our Royal Will and Pleafure, that the faid Parliament fhall, on the faid Twenty-feventh Day of November next, be held and fit for the Difpatch of divers urgent and important Affairs : And the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgeffes, and the Commiffioners for Shires and Burgefs, of the Houfe of Commons, are hereby required and commanded to give their Attendance accordingly at Weftminfter on the faid Twenty feventh Day of November next.

Given at Our Court at the Queen's Palace, the Tenth Day of October, One thousand eight hundred and fix, in the Forty-fixth Year of Our Reign.

## PRESENT.

The KING's Moft Excellent Majefty in Council.

W HEREAS by an Act paffed in the laft Seffion of Parliament, intituled "An Act for enabling His Majefty to permit the Importation and Exportation of certain Goods and Commodities into and from the Port of Road Harbour, in the Ifland of Tortola;" It is enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to permit the Importation into the faid Port of Road Harbour, in the Ifland

of Tortola, one of the Virgin Islands, and the Exportation from thence into this Kingdom, of all luch Articles, Goods, and Commodities as are permitted by an Act-paffed in the Forty-fifth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to confolidate the feveral Laws now in force for allowing the Importation and Exportation of certain Goods and Merchandize into and from certain Ports in the Welt Indies," to be imported into the Port of Naffau, in the Island of New Providence, one of the Bahama Islands, and to be exported from thence to this Kingdom, in the fame Manner, on the fame Duties and Drawbacks, and fubject to the fame Rules, Regulations, Restrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures as are provided in the faid laft-mentioned AA, respecting the Importation into, and Exportation from the Port of Nassau, and further subject to such Rules, Regulations, Conditions, and Reftrictions as fhall, from Time to Time be directed by His Majefty, by and with the Advice aforefaid ; His Majelty is thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered, that from and after the Date hereof, and till further order, it shall be lawful to import into the faid Port of Road Harbour, in the Island of Tortola, one of the Virgin Islands, and to export from thence into this Kingdom, all fuch Articles, Goods, and Commodities as are permitted by the last-mentioned Act, to be imported into the faid Island of Nassau, and to be exported from thence into this Kingdom, in the fame Manner, on the fame Duties and Drawbacks, and fubject to the fame Rules, Regulations, Restrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures as are provided in the fuid last-mentioned A& respecting Importation into, and Exportation from the Port of Naffau, and further subject to the Conditions, Rules, and Regulations hereinafter mentioned, that is to fay, that before any Sugar or Coffee, the Produce of Tortola and its Dependencies, fhall be permitted or fuffered to be shipped or laden on board any Ship or Veffel, each and every Package shall be stamped or marked by the proper Officer of the Customs in Roman Letters, of not less than Two Inches in Length, with the Words BRITISH PLANTA-TION; provided always, that no fuch Sugar or Coffee, the Produce of Tortola and its Dependen-
