and to administer the Oaths required by Law to be taken there by the faid Peers, and to take their Votes; and immediately after fuch Election made, and duly examined, to certify the Names of the Sixteen Peers fo elected, and fign and attest the fame, in the Prefence of the faid Pcers the Electors; and return fuch Certificate into Our High Court of Chancery of Great Britain. And We do, by this Our Proclamation, strictly command and require the Provost of Edinburgh, and all other the Magistrates of the faid City, to take efpecial Care to preferve the Peace thereof, during the Time of the faid Election ; and to prevent all Manner of Riots, Tumults, Diforders, and Violence whatfoever. And We strictly charge and command, that this Our Royal Proclamation be duly published at the Market Crois at Edinburgh, and in all the County Towns of Scotland, Twenty-five Days at least before the Time hereby appointed for the Meeting of the faid Peers to proceed to fuch Election.

WHEREAS by an Act paffed in the laft Seffion of Parliament, intituled " An Act for enabling His Majetty to permit the Importation and Exportation of certain Goods and Commodities into and from the Port of Road Harbour, in the Island of Tortola ;" It is enacted, that it shall and may be lawful for His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to permit the Importation into the faid Port of Road Harbour, in the Island of Tortola, one of the Virgin Iflands, and the Exportation from thence into this Kingdom, of all luch Articles, Goods, and Commodities as are permitted by an Act paffed in the Forty-fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to confolidate the several Laws now in force for allowing the Importation and Exportation of certain Goods and Merchandize into and from certain Ports in the West Indies," to be imported into the Port of Naffau, in the Ifland of New Providence, one of the Bahama Hlands, and to be exported from thence to this Kingdom, in the fame Manner, on the fame Duties and Drawbacks, and fubject to the fame Rules, Regulations, Reltrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures as are provided in the faid laft-mentioned Act, respecting the Importation into, and Exportation. from the Port of Nassau, and further subject to such Rules, Regulations, Conditions, and Restrictions as shall, from Time to Time be directed by His Majesty, by and with the Advice aforefaid ; His Majelty is thereupon pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered, that from and after the Date hereof, and till further

, order, it shall be lawful to import into the faid Port of Road Harbour, in the Island of Tortola, one of the Virgin Islands, and to export from thence into this Kingdom, all fuch Articles, Goods, and Commodities as are permitted by the last-mentioned Act, to be imported into the faid Island of Nastau, and to be exported from thence into this Kingdom, in the fame Manner, on the fame Duties and Drawbacks, and fubject to the fame Rules, Regulations, Restrictions, Penalties, and Forfeitures as are provided in the faid last-mentioned A& respecting Importation into, and Exportation from the Port of Nallau, and further subject to the Conditions, Rules, and Regulations hereinafter mentioned, that is to fay, that before any Sugar or Coffee, the Produce of Tortola and its Dependencies, shall be permitted or fuffered to be shipped or laden on board any Ship or Veffel, each and every Package shall be stamped or marked by the proper Officer of the Cuftoms in Roman Letters, of not lefs than Two Inches in Length, with the Words BRITISH PLANTA-TION; provided always, that no fuch Sugar or Coffee, the Produce of Tortola and its Dependencies as aforefaid, shall be for stamped or marked, except on Application in Writing from the Proprietor of the Plantation, on which fuch Sugar or Coffee was actually produced, or his or her Agent or Ma-nager, fpecifying the Quantity of fuch Sugar or Coffee, and the Number and Weight of the Packages, containing the fame respectively, the Name or Defeription of the Plantation, where the fame, and the Year in which the fame actually grew, and addreffed to the Collector or other principal Officer of His Majefty's Cuftoms, and fuch Collector or other principal Officer, shall caufe the faid Packages to be duly weighed and examined, and if the fame fhall be found to correspond with fuch Application, and the Sugar or Coffee contained therein shall be proved on the Oath of the Party, or otherwife, to the Satisfaction of fuch Collector or other principal Officer to be, bona fide, the Growth or Produce of the Plantation mentioned as described in fuch Ap-plication, he shall cause the same to be so stamped or marked in the Order in which fuch Applications shall have been made, and not otherwife; provided alfo, that in cale Application shall be to made in any One Year, ending the Thirty first of December, for itamping or marking a greater Quantity of Sugar than 5,880,000 lbs., that Quan-tity, and no more, shall be to stamped or marked, and the Remainder shall be stamped or marked in the next Year in the Order in which Application shall have been made for the fame, fucceflively, unlefs the Proprietor, &c. shall be willing that fuch Sugar or Coffee shall be stamped or marked as Foreign, in Manner hereafter-mentioned, and exported as fuch from the faid Ifland ; and that all Sugar and Coffee, not being the Produce of the British Plantations or Territories, shall, upon Importation into the Port of Road Harbour, be laid on Land, and examined, and fhall be deposited in fafe and secure Warehouses, under the joint Locks of His Majefty, and the Owner or Proprietor of fuch Sugar and Coffee; and the fame shall not afterwards be shipped or laden on hoard any Ship or Vessel, unless directly from such Warehouses, (upon due Entry thereof being first made,) under the Care and Inspection of the proper Officer of the Cultoms; and before any fuch Sugar or Coffee shall be permitted or suffered to be shipped
