

Council, in obedience to His Majesty's said Directions expressed in the said Order, and in pursuance of the Powers and Authorities contained in the said Act first above-mentioned, have accordingly apportioned, and do hereby apportion among the several Counties in England, Two Hundred Thousand Men, according to the several Numbers specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed for each of the said Counties respectively, and amounting in the Whole to Two Hundred Thousand Men, and which Schedule His Majesty's Privy Council are pleased to direct shall be taken as Part of this Order; and His Majesty's Privy Council do hereby also direct that this Order, and the Schedule hereunto annexed, be transmitted to the respective Lieutenants of the said Counties in England, in order that they should proceed upon the same, in pursuance of the Directions of the said Act of Parliament first above-mentioned; and His Majesty's Privy Council do hereby further direct, that this Order, and the said Schedule to the same annexed, be Thrice printed in the London Gazette.
