

Whitehall, May 11, 1807.

The King has been pleased to grant unto Thomas Strickland, of Sizergh, in the County of Westmoreland, Esq; His Royal Licence and Authority, that he may take and use the Surname of Standish, in Addition to, and after that of Strickland, and also bear the Arms of Standish, quarterly with those of Strickland; and that such of his Issue as shall from Time to Time possess and enjoy the Inheritance of certain Estates at Standish, in the County Palatine of Lancaster, bequeathed by the Will of his Maternal Uncle, Edward Towneley Standish, late of Standish Hall, Esq; deceased, may take and use the Surname and bear the Arms of Standish only; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Herald's Office:

And also to order, that this His Majesty's Concession and Declaration be recorded in His College of Arms.
