BY THE LORDS COMMISSIONERS OF HIS MAJESTY'S TREASURY.

WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the Forty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, "An Act for permitting certain Goods imported into Great Britain to be secured in Warehouses without Payment of Duty," it is, amongst other Things, enacted as follows, "That it shall be lawful for the Importer or Importers, Proprietor or Proprietors, Consignee or Consignees of any Goods, Wares, and Merchandizes enumerated or described in the Table hereunto annexed, marked (E), and which shall be legally imported or brought into the Port of London, to lodge and secure the same in a Warehouse or Warehouses to be provided for that Purpose, any such Goods, Wares, and Merchandize under the joint Locks of the Crowns and the Merchant, without Payment at the
